

SPECIAL MEETING OF OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL NOVEMBER 21, 1979

The purpose of the meeting was Second Reading of Ordinance 79-25, "An Ordinance to Authorize Oconee County to Sell \$500,000 Bond Anticipation Note in Connection with Ordinance 78-6, Issuance of General Obligations Public Purpose Bonds of Oconee County for Purchase of Oconee County Rock Crusher". Dr. Earle moved for its adoption on Second Reading, Mr. Crain seconded and the vote was 3 yes and 0 no.
