**MINUTES, SPECIAL MEETING, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL**

There was an emergency meeting of the Oconee County Council Friday, May 15, 1992 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all members except Mr. Strickland present.

Members of the press present: Carol Kreklar - Anderson Independent & Ron Barnett - Greenville News.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media. Call to Order

Mr. Crain informed those present that there was a leak in the propane gas tank at the Law Enforcement Center. He further stated they did not think there was any danger, however they did want to be ready in the event it became necessary to evacuate the building. LEC

Mr. Crain further informed Council that the gas company at first said the tank would have to be excavated and taken to their facility before it could be emptied and repaired. However, the company had since said the gas could be burned off, a process that would take eight (8) to ten (10) hours and this process had already begun. There is another tank which they think can be cut off and not have to be burned off.

Mr. Crain also stated they would like to have the tanks converted to natural gas.

It was the consensus of Council that funds be taken from contingency to correct the situation and Mr. Crain do whatever becomes necessary to see that the situation is corrected and that no one is in danger.
