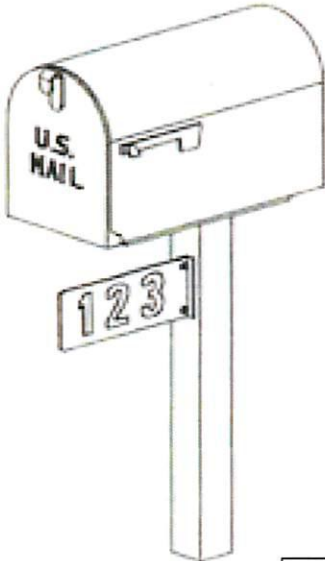


# Protect your family and your property. POST YOUR ADDRESS NUMBER



It's the law.

(Section 10-74, Oconee County Code of Ordinances)

Seconds count during emergencies. If your house can't be located, time is wasted. To help emergency response personnel find your home, post a reflective address number sign. Here's how to get your sign:



1. Submit the form below, or
2. Call Emergency Services at (864) 638-4200, or
3. Purchase reflective materials according to these guidelines:
  - House numbers should be at least 4 inches high.
  - Business numbers should be at least 4 inches high.
  - Numbers should be in contrast color from the background.

All signs shall be posted on, above, or at the side of the main entrance so it can be seen from the street. If the building is more than 50 feet from the street, post an additional sign at the end of the driveway.
