#### MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, February 4, 1986 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members present.

Members of the press notified (by mail): Seneca Journal, Keowee Courier, Greenville News, Anderson Independent, WGOG Radio, WSNW Radio & WCCP Radio.

Members of the press present: Ed Miller - Greenville News, Dave Partenheimer - WSNW Radio, John Durham - WCCP Radio, Ashton Hester - Keowee Courier & Mike Petrovsky - Seneca Journal.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Dyar.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that the minutes of the January 21, 1986 meeting be adopted as printed.

Mr. Doug Phillips, representative of Council of Governments, presented the attached proposed funding proposal for COG to County Council. Mr. Phillips informed Council that all membership counties of COG would have to agree to this formula before it became effective.

After much discussion, Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 4-1 (Mr. Butts voting against) that Oconee County Council approve this formula.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Van Lott be awarded the bid for a front end loader for the CCS Department at a cost of \$110,029.19 plus \$2,500 for an extended warranty contingent upon receiving the insurance check for the front end loader that was destroyed by fire at the Seneca Landfill.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Resolution 86-2, "A Resolution Designating Anderson-Oconee Council on Aging as an Entity in Oconee County to provide Transportation to the Elderly and/or Handicapped".

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Resolution 86-3, "A Resolution Designating the Oconee County Association of Retarded Citizens as an Entity in Oconee County to Provide Transportation to the Elderly and/or Handicapped".

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the attached Arts Contract be approved.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 3 - 2 (Mr. Butts & Mr. Dyar voting against) that the Arts & Historical Commission be allowed to enter into a Consortium of Arts Council or Commissions if it is legal.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfer(s) be approved.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that due to the fact that Slagle Fire Equipment & Supply Co., Inc. would not honor their bid on the coats, all rural fir equipment previously awarded to Slagle be awarded the next highest bidder. The bid for the fifty (50) coats at \$139.50 each will go to Anderson Fire & Safety Equipment Co., the bid for two (2) six foot pike poles will go to Carl R. Dickert Co. at \$47.00 each, and the bid for thirty two (32) dry chemical cartridges at \$18.00 each will go to Anderson Fire & Safety Equipment Co.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 3-2 (Mr. Williams & Mr. Harper voting against) that Slagle Fire Equipment & Supply Co., Inc. be barred from bidding on county equipment for a period of two (2) years.

 $\,$  Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that Council go into executive session to discuss some legal matters.

When open session resumed, Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that the windload on the hanger doors at the Oconee County Airport be changed to thirty-five (35) pounds per square foot at no cost to the county and it be done with sixty (60) days.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that the county seek bids for the title searches that will have to be done a on approximately one hundred, twelve (112) parcels of property that are to be sold for delinquent taxes.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5-0 that the county accept the attached lease with Blue Ridge Electric for their vacant building in Westminster.
