## MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, February, 16, 1988 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

All other persons who have requested to be notified of meetings were also notified by mail.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Meeting Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Dr. Earle.

Mr. Crain asked that it be made a part of the public record of his and Council's congratulations to Mr. Bob Strother on being named Director of the Council of Governments.

Mr. Strother introduced Ms. Julie Strickland who will be covering the Oconee County Council Meetings.

Next on the agenda was a public hearing concerning the abandonment by the county of County Roadway Ch 4 which runs through the property of Mr. Blake Griffith, Ms. Kim Reese and Ms. Gladys Reese. All three of the property owners have signed a request that this roadway be abandoned. Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that this request be honored.

At the request of Ms. Debbie Thomason of the Humane Society and Ms. Lindsay Fields, President of the Humane Society, Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5-0 that the attached addendum to the agreement by and between Oconee County and the Oconee County Humane Society be adopted.

Also at the request of the Humane Society, Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Harper out of room) that some of the animals that are not adopted after the five (5) day holding period could be assigned to the Humane Society before they are put to sleep for a thirty (30) day period to give the animal an opportunity to be adopted.

At the request of Sheriff Earle Holcombe, Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 4 - 1 (Mr. Dyar voting against) that the bid for the summer uniforms for the Sheriff's Department be awarded to the higher bidder for the color, quality and the fact that they could match the patch exactly. They are also on the deputies' way when they go to Columbia. The total of the bid is \$3,064.74. (See attached bid)

Neal, Route 2, Box 543, Winstead Road, West Union, S. C. 29696 be appointed to replace him with his term commencing immediately and expiring June 30, 1991.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the attached two (2) transfers be approved.

COG Appointments

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. Robert Gaillard & Mrs. Lucille Battle be be reappointed to Board of the Council of Governments with their terms commencing immediately and expiring January 1, 1991.

PRT Appt.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. John Barnett be appointed to fill the unexpired term of the late Mr. Claude Wooten of the PRT Commission with his term commencing immediately and expiring January 1, 1990.

Literacy Program

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - O that the Department of Social Services be permitted to allow the Oconee County Literacy Program to use whatever room might be available for use for tutors who are helping Oconee County residents complete the GED or Adult High School Program of Oconee County.

Duke Bonds

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that Wachovia Bank & Trust be permitted to replace lost Duke Power Project Bonds owned by the The Exchange Bank of Kingstree as per attached request.

Local Gov. Finance Act

After discussion, Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Butts our of room) that each Council Member individually contact Senator Alexander Macaulay to convey their feelings to him concerning the Local Government Finance Act.
