MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, April 3, 1990 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media. The guests included some students from the governmental class at Seneca High School.

The invocation was given by Mr. Dyar.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone that the minutes of the March 20, 1990 meeting be adopted as printed. Mr. Dyar pointed out that the second paragraph from the top on page four should read that Mayor Finley was going to go back to the appropriate committee to discuss the withdrawal of the City of Westminster to use some of the office space in the Governmental Building in Westminster until the lease between the County and Blue Ridge Electric has been resolved.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5-0 that the minutes of the March 20, 1990 meeting amended as above and then the minutes as amended were adopted 5-0.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that \$1,000 be transferred from medical into out of county travel in the Sheriff's Department. (See attachment)

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that the county apply for a South Carolina Aeronautics Grant in the amount of \$11,250 to go toward the sealing of the cracks on the runway at the airport; that \$1,250 be taken from contingency and the \$10,000 in the budget be used for this purpose as this is a 50-50 match.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that Pace Pavement Technologies be awarded the bid for the sealing of the cracks on the runway, apron and taxiway at the airport for a total cost of \$22,500 contingent upon Pace doing a test area to our satisfaction and a representative from the South Carolina Aeronautics Commission being there to see that it meets their requirements.

Mr. Chris Caley of Metro Engineering presented the attached proposed electrical system for South Cove Park and High Falls Park. The total cost of the project is \$64,700 for South Cove and \$70,800 for High Falls. After discussion, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that the county apply for a state grant for these expenditures.

At the request of Mr. Wendell Walker, PRT Director, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that \$3,066 be taken from contingency and placed in line item number 10 018 00150 00023 for repair the slip docks at High Falls Park.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5-0 that \$516 be taken from contingency and placed in line item number 10 018 00150 00022 to replace the dishwasher and repair the floor of the residence at South Cove Park.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that PRT apply for a grant in the amount of \$1,500 (subject to approval in the 1990-91 budget or contingency funds) to the South Carolina Tourism Funds-Sharing Program for the printing of brochures.

Mr. Stone made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that the attached request for a JTPA Worker for the Magistrate's Office be approved.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 90-3, "Depot Street Communications, Inc. Cable TV Ordinance" be adopted on third and final reading.

There was \$30,000 appropriated for the building of the Veterans Affairs Office, of this it appears there will be some \$4,000 left, Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that \$1,850 be used to purchase furniture for the office.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5-0 that a smoke detective system for the Walhalla Library be considered in the regular budget process.

Mr. Crain informed Council that the donation of \$17,500 toward the purchase of an automation system for the Library had been withdrawn.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5-0 that the bid for food the Law Enforcement Center be approved as delineated on the attached bid sheet.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5-0 that Blanchard Machinery be awarded the bid for rental of a dozer for the road department at \$6,500. (see attached bid)

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5-0 that consideration of a contract for an alarm system for Lunney Museum be postponed until a representative for the museum can be present.
