MINUTES, SPECIAL MEETING, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Oconee County Council held a special Council Meeting, Tuesday, June 8, 1993 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members present.

Members of the press notified (by mail): Journal/Tribune, Keowee Courier, Westminster News, Anderson Independent, Greenville News, WGOG Radio, WBFM News, WZLI/WLET Radio, WCCP Radio, WYFF TV & WLOS TV.

Members of the press present: George Allgood - WGOG Radio, McGregor McCance - Greenville News & Eric Gorsky - Anderson Independent.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Williams.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Orr, approved 4 - 1 (Mrs. Burrell voting against) that the attached transfer for the Board of Registration be adopted.

At the request of Mr. Michael Crenshaw, Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Burrell, approved 5 - 0 that \$8,955 be taken from contingency and placed in the Sheriff's Budget as the county's matching portion of the DARE Grant in the amount of \$26,853. Also that the funds recommended in the 1993-94 budget for the matching portion of this grant remain in the budget for the 1994-95 fiscal year. This was done due to the fact the grant has to be executed by the Supervisor-Chairman and returned to the Governor's Office by June 21, 1993. (See attached grant offer from the Governor's Office)

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 93-6, "The 1993-94 Oconee County Budget Ordinance" be adopted on first reading in title only.

At the request of Mr. Strickland, Mr. Crain explained that Clemson University was dragging its feet on the Regional Solid Waste Landfill concept. He had reminded Clemson at the meeting on June 7, 1993 that it was Clemson that approached the three (3) counties regarding this matter.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0 that the county proceed with a grant application to the Governor's Office for the purchase of a



RE: ROSA CLARK CLINIC

Dear Chairman and Council Members:

Following up on your suggestion that a building be found to relocate the clinic, our medical staff and members of the Board of Directors inspected Dr. Charles Battle's vacated office in Seneca. It was found the location, contents and paved off street parking are completely suitable for our needs. The cost, including essential repairs is approximately \$140,000.

Please consider this our urgent request to be taken up at your next meeting. Dr. Battle has given us first choice, with a decision by June 15th.

In addition to this matter, please refer to our letter of March 1, 1993. Due to the problems created by the resignation of George Parsons as executive director, it will be necessary to use the \$4,000 to hire a partime person for twenty hours a week to keep continuity in this operation.
