MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, November 16, 1993 at 3:00 pm in Council Chambers with all Council Members except Mr. Williams present. Mr. Timothy M. Cain, County Attorney was also present.

Members of the press present: Ashton Hester - Keowee Courier, Eric Gorsky - Anderson Independent, Lee Hendren - Journal/Tribune and Jennifer Berry - Greenville News.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Orr.

Mr. Orr made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Williams absent) that the minutes of the October 2, 1993 meeting be adopted as printed.

Ms. Donna Kazia of SC Appalachian Council of Governments addressed Council regarding the attached job that were appealed and/or corrected. Ms. Kazia explained to Council that none of the corrections made changed the classification or grade for these job descriptions. After discussion, Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Orr approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Williams absent) that these job descriptions be adopted as presented.
