MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, March 19, 1996 at 3:00 pm in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

Members of the press notified (by mail): Journal/Tribune, Keowee Courier, Westminster News, Anderson Independent, Greenville News, WGOG Radio, WBFM Radio, WCCP Radio, WYFF TV, WLOS TV & SC Black Media Group.

Members of the press present: Ashton Hester - Keowee Courier & Greg Oliver - Journal/Tribune.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor -Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Hamilton.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the March 5, 1996 meeting be adopted as printed.

Upon request of Mr. Karl Addis, Coroner, Mr. Strickland made a motion that \$21,967 plus tax be taken from contingency to purchase a 4X4 Bronco for the Coroner's use. However, this motion died for lack of second.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Ms. Burrell, approved 4 - 1 (Mr. Strickland voting against) that the Motor Pool Foreman assign a car to the Coroner's Office that is suitable for that use. Mr. Addis stated he has been driving the county vehicle to his private job at Clemson University. Council did not instruct Mr. Addis to do otherwise.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Ms. Burrell, approved 5 - 0 that Resolution 96-5, "A RESOLUTION MAKING APPLICATION TO THE STATE BUDGET AND CONTROL BOARD OF SOUTH CAROLINA FOR APPROVAL OF THE ISSUANCE BY OCONEE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, OF \$6,500,000 IN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF ITS POLLUTION CONTROL REVENUE REFUNDING BONDS (ENGELHARD CORPORATION PROJECT), SERIES 1996, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SOUTH CAROLINA CODE ANNOTATED, TITLE 4, CHAPTER 29 (1976), AS AMENDED" be adopted on first and final reading.

Ms. Burrell made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 96-2, "A THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF OCONEE COUNTY REFUNDING REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 1996 AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO" be adopted on second reading.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Orr, approved 5 - 0 that the bid for oil products to be used at the Motor Pool be awarded to Taylor Enterprises, Inc. who was low bid at \$21,569.45 for approximate amounts needed. (See attached bid sheet)

Upon recommendation of Mr. Jim Smith, Public Buildings Director & Ms. Marianne Dillard, Purchasing Agent, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Orr, approved 5 - 0 that no award be made for a roof for the Public Service Building as only one bid was received and they felt it was excessively high for the number of squares it will take to cover the Public Service Building.

Further, Mr. Crain asked Mr. Smith to schedule a meeting with the City of Walhalla officials to discuss requirements for vendors to do business with Oconee County inside the city limits.

Upon recommendation of Ms. Dillard, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 5 0 that Butts Construction Co. be retained to mow the watershed dams at a total cost of \$2,830 for the eight (8) dams.

Upon request of Mr. Alex James, PRT Director, Mr. Hamilton made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0 that PRT apply for the attached SC Tourism Marketing Partnership Program Grant in the amount of \$673.75 with a matching amount of \$551.25 which will be included in the 1996-97 PRT budget. PRT does not have to accept the grant if matching funds are not approved and/or not available.

Mr. James also informed Council that he had received an extension on the grants for the proposed pedestrian bridge at Chau Ram Park and at this time he is looking at re-bidding the project.

Upon request of Mr. Buddy Hawk, Right-of-Way /911 Technician, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 5 - 0 that a private phone line be installed at Tokeena, Westminster and Salem for testing the 911 system to go along with the emergency line so that calls can be returned within the area at a cost of \$507 for installation and \$134 monthly to be paid from the current 911 toll on phone bills.

Further, Council approved by consensus the purchase of two (2) answering machines for the testing of these lines.

Mr. Orr, Chairman, Hospital Study Committee, informed Council it was the recommendation of the committee that the County Attorney and the Hospital Attorney determine if the Hospital Board Members can be selected by public election. This recommendation was adopted unanimously.

The Roads & Transportation Committee scheduled a meeting Tuesday, March 26, 1996 at 8:30 am in Council Chambers for the purpose of making a field trip to review roadways for possible paving in the 1995-96 fiscal year.

Upon Mr. Williams inquiry, Mr. Cain, County Attorney, informed Council he had assured one of the property owners on Oak Valley Farms Roadway he would look at it again with Mr. Hawk, Right-of-Way Technician.

After a ten minute recess, Mr. Hamilton, during his committee report recognized Mr. Steven Moore and Mr. Howard Moore of Round Mountain Orchard who addressed Council regarding Ordinance 95-10, "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH FOR OCONEE COUNTY PROVISION TO IDENTIFY AND MONITOR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS AND PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE".

They informed Council that all chemicals in their warehouse were reported to Emergency Preparedness, the Rural Fire Departments, DHEC, OSHA, Department of Labor, EPA and other state and federal agencies.

They further informed Council that no one would have to work very hard to get around the ordinance as it is presently written and suggested that the information regarding hazardous materials be posted on the doors of all businesses that store such materials.

Council scheduled a public hearing regarding the above mentioned ordinance Tuesday, April 9, 1996 at 7:00 pm at the courthouse.

Council also scheduled a meeting with Tri County Technical College Monday, April 1, 1996 at 6:30 pm at the Blue Ridge Electric Building regarding their 1996-97 budget request.
