#### MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, July 15, 1997 at 3:00 pm in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Call to - Chairman Orr who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Thomas.

Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 4 - 0 (Ms. Burrell abstaining) that the minutes of the June 17, 1997 be adopted as printed.

Upon request of Mr. Daniel Whitehurst & Mr. David Hooper of the Department of Social Services, Mr. Timms made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 5 - 0 that Oconee County enter into the attached agreement by and between the South Carolina Department of Social Services Family Independence Program and Work Experience Provider & Oconee County to Provide Employment for Welfare Recipients be adopted.

Upon request of Mr. Alex James, PRT Drt., Ms. PRT Burrell made a motion, seconded by Mr. Timms, approved 5 - 0 that Parks, Recreation & Tourism be given the authority to apply for a Watercraft Recreational Fund Grant in the amount of \$8,000 to go toward the purchase of a boat and a vehicle.

Also upon request of Mr. James, Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 5 - 0 that PRT be given the authority to apply for a SC Recreational Trails Fund Grant in the amount of \$5,500 for trail maintenance equipment and trail construction materials.

Fee in Lieu of Taxes

Auditing

Upon request of Mr. Robert Gaillard, Economic Director, Ms. Burrell made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 5 - 0 that Council adopt the concept of a fee in lieu of taxes at 6% of approximately \$45,000,000 for Westpoint Stevens, Inc. for an equipment upgrade.

Sewer Grants

Upon request of Mr. Gaillard & Mr. Robert Winchester, Sewer Commission Superintendent, Mr. Hamilton made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 5 - 0 that the county seek grants for a sewer line to the new Vocational Rehabilitation Building and expend approximately \$200 for an engineer's study.

To Mr. Timms' inquiry, Mr. Cain informed Council that Mr. Dirk Reis of the SC Appalachian Council of Governments is continuing to work toward a solution of the Newry Sewer problem.

Newry Sewer

Mr. Hamilton, Chairman, Land Use Committee, recommended that Council engage the SC Appalachian Council of Governments to provide technical assistance on the land use plan. This recommendation was adopted unanimously by Council.

Land Use

Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 5 - 0 that Council ratify Energetic Solutions executing a shot at the Rock Crusher before their contract went into effect July, 1997.

Rock Crusher

Mr. Hamilton made a motion, seconded by Mr. Thomas, approved 5 - 0 that Council ratify the Sheriff's Office applying for a Local Law Enforcement Block Grant which had to be returned before the Council Meeting.

Upon request of Mrs. Phyllis Lombard, Finance Director, Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mr. Timms, approved 5 - 0 that \$6,300 be taken from contingency and placed in line item 010 009 00150 00025 for additional taxes on fuel purchased at the airport.

Mrs. Hughes made a motion, seconded by Ms. Burrell, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. Archie Barron be reappointed to the Pendleton District Workforce Development Board. This is a three year term commencing immediately and expiring June 30, 2000.

# **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

# FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 26 th day of geley 1996, by and between OCONEE COUNTY (hereinafter "the County") and BYERLEY & PAYNE, P. A. and KIRK S. MESSICK, P. A. (hereinafter "the Provider")

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County has requested proposals/bids from various providers for purpose of obtaining from the County the services of a professional in the field of Accounting and Auditing: and

WHEREAS, Byerley & Payne, P. A. and Kirk S. ## 3. Special Conditions

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this agreement, the agreements in the bid and the proposal incorporated herein by reference, the following special conditions will apply. Should any

such special condition be in conflict with the proposal or bid, these conditions shall be submitted for and be in lieu of any other provisions of the bid or the proposal, to wit:

All audits performed by the Provider under this Contract shall meet the requirements of OMB Circular A-128, Single Audit Act of 1984, so as to meet the requirements of the various federal agencies whose funds are received and expended by the County.
