

MINUTES OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING JANUARY 15, 1976

An emergency meeting of the Oconee County Council was called to order by Chairman Bailes. Invocation offered by Mayor Bob Gilliard.

Solicitor Laniel Chapman discussed the need for a Drug Squad for Oconee County. He requested this squad be composed of a Drug Officer and two unidentified undercover Agents. This proposed Squad to work under a 5 member Board one member County Council, one from the Legislative Delegation, One from the School System, One from the Police Depts from the 3 cities(on a rotating basis) and the Sheriff. This request was referred to the Law Enforcement Committee.

Finance Chairman Thomas presented Revenue Sharing checks (based on 1972 census) to the five incorporated towns.

County Attorney Jerry Fedder told Council that the Constitutional Amendment to the Home Rule Bill requires a referendum on the proposed sewer project for the major population areas of the County. This was referred to the Finance Committee for a report back at the January 22 meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 9 P.M. for interviews with Purchasing Director Applicants.
