

MINUTES OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING JULY 22, 1976

The Council meeting was opened by Chairman Bailes with the prayer by Bobby Jenkins. Buddy Herring was the only Member absent.

Mr. Ramey moved, Mr. Moore seconded and it was carried to approve minutes of the July 8th meeting as printed.

Mr. Thomas moved to allow Planning Commission Director, Dick Plyler, to proceed with the "Oconee Story" Publication, but then amended the motion to first see if this Brochure could be published locally, with Mr. Thomas and Mr. Ramey to check with local publishers. Mr. Moore seconded and it was carried.
