

M I N U T E S

OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

JUNE 23, 1977

The County Council met in special session for the 2nd reading of the Budget Ordinance. The meeting was opened by Chairman Phinney. Present for the meeting: Councilmen Bailes, Cox, Crain, Frady and Ables. Absent: Moore, Herring and Thomas.

Mr. Bailes moved to make the following amendments to the Budget:

1. Change number of Ordinance from 77-4 to 77-6
2. Change tax assessment ratio in Section 7 from 3% to 2½%
3. Carry over to 1977-78 PRT budget \$24,463.64 (this is for completion of South Cove Tennis Courts, Asphalt paving at Chau Ram and Community Club projects which will not be completed by June 30)

Mr. Cox seconded the motion for the amendments - the vote was unanimously in favor.

Mr. Bailes then moved to adopt on 2nd reading Budget Ordinance 77-6. Mr. Ables seconded and the vote was 5 for and 0 against.

Mrs. Virginia Sibley, Comptroller, asked Council if she could be heard. Council first told her she would have to be placed on an agenda at a future meeting. Mr. Ables suggested to Council Members to give Mrs. Sibley permission to talk to them and it was agreed. Mrs. Sibley requested her salary be adjusted some \$2,000.00 to \$3,000.00 to place her in line with other appointed officials. After discussion it was agreed the personnel committee would look into the matter and advise her later.

Mr. Frady moved to adjourn, Mr. Ables seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 7:35 P.M.
