

MINUTES OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING JULY 19, 1977

The County Council meeting was opened by Chairman Phinney. Invocation by Cecil Cox. All Members were present.

Mr. Howard Adams of the Sewer Commission presented the 208 Countywide Wastewater Management Plan. This Plan was discussed by Mr. Adams and Council Members and Mr. Ables moved to adopt it. Mr. Herring seconded however, Council decided to postpone acceptance until next meeting in order to have more time to study it.

Ordinance #77-7 Establishing a Governing Board for Oconee Childrens Home was adopted on 1st reading. The motion was made by Mr. Thomas seconded by Mr. Herring and carried.

Civil Defense Director June Black explained the new Federal Assistance Plan whereby a Representative from Columbia Office will now be able to come here to evaluate any disaster and determine on the scene if we would be eligible for federal funds.

Chairman Phinney gave the following update:

Public works application for EDA funds (286,000.00) is in Atlanta and hopefully will be approved in approximately 6 weeks

Grant for road signs is complete

Personnel evaluation by COG will be complete in 2 to 3 weeks

A total of 37 new jobs filled under Public Service Employment

Annex renovation has been completed and Rehabilitation Office has been moved there. Cost of renovation and 4 air conditioners was \$5,746.00.

Low bidder for printing 1977-78 budgets was Seneca Journal. Their bid was \$475.00. The other bidder was Keowee Courier with a bid of \$485.00.

So far this year 24.4 miles of roads have been paved, 20 miles recapped and 10 miles now ready for paving

Announced that Bill Yarborough was hired as the Administrator for the Law Enforcement Center

Mr. Thomas moved to go into executive session to discuss personnel. Mr. Cox seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 4.30 P.M.
