

MINUTES OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular Oconee County Council Meeting was held April 7, 1981 with all members present.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain.

The invocation was given by Mr. Butts.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 4 - 0 to approve the minutes of the March 17, 1981 meeting. Dr. Earle then explained that Council went into Executive Session at that meeting to discuss the possibility of an Industrial Revenue Bond Sale, no action was taken at that time.

First on the agenda was the Proposed Budget for 1980-81 Supplemental Appropriation. Mr. Crain stated that on March 25, 1981 at 1:00 P.M. there was a Public Revenue Sharing Meeting held in the Council Chambers with the majority of Council present.

Mr. Wynn stated the two requests made at that meeting were Mrs. Nora A. King who asked for \$19,400 for Oconee Community Theater and Joyce Jackson of the School Department who asked for from \$12,000 to \$15,000 to fund a camp for E. H. Children.

Mr. Wynn then stated there would be a second Public Hearing held April 21, 1981 at 3:00 P.M. prior to the Council Meeting.

Mr. Crain presented a Proposed 1980-81 Supplemental Budget as follows: A. \$150,000 from uncommitted Revenue Sharing Funds to be transferred to line item 67 00 01R to wipe out the deficit incurred for Sewer Lagoons at Walhalla, Westminster & Seneca. B. \$100,000 interest earned from Bonds sold for the Hospital Annex to be placed in Contingency to use at Council discretion. C. \$5,000 is to be transferred from Comptroller's Budget, line item 36 11 00L to Supervisor's Budget, line item 22 12 00L - Part-time Clerks. D. \$20,000 to line item 09 99 01L, Donations, Grants & Reimbursements from donations, grants & reimbursements received by the Aeronautics Commission and previously deposited with the Treasurer's Office, \$2,000 of the above referenced donations, grants & reimbursements is to be transferred to the Supervisor's Office, line item 12 54 22L - Fuel, as reimbursement for fuel used in construction at the airport.

Rebecca Schmidt of Charity Medical appeared before Council to request funds for Personnel at Lakeview Rest Home as they will be losing their Ceta employee. A full time employee would cost \$8263.08 including fringe and a part time employee would cost \$3484.

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Mr. Brandt suggested this matter be taken into committee at this time.

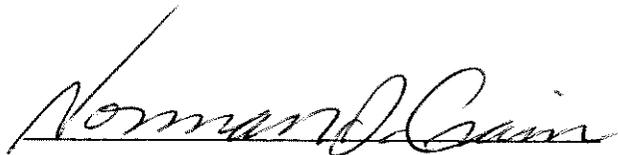
Dr. Earle stated they had met with EMS and they were hoping to have a solution worked out soon.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Brandt, approved 4 - 0 to accept Dr. E. N. Davis' resignation from Emergency Preparedness and the Mental Health Clinic Board and to send him a letter of appreciation.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Brandt, approved 4 - 0 to allow the Planning Commission to pick their Ceta employee under line item 22 12 00L for the remainder of this fiscal year.

Dr. Earle stated the School Department's Budget for 1982 was a total of \$14,759,555 which is \$1,093,000 more than last year. He then made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 4 - 0 to give the School Department \$500,000 in additional local revenue for the 1982 budget. The Council was in agreement that this was all the county could commit at this time and it was urgent they make a commitment now due to the School Department having to send out Teacher's contracts.
