

MINUTES, SPECIAL MEETING OF OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL

A special meeting of the Oconee County Council was held May 13, 1981 at 9:00 A.M. with all members present.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain.

Mr. Fedder, County Attorney requested Council go into Executive Session. This was made into the form of a motion by Mr. Williams, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 4 - 0.

Council went back into open session at 9:55 A.M. and Mr. Crain read Resolution 81-8 Authorizing An Inducement Contract between Oconee County, South Carolina and Steel Heddle Mfg. Co. Relating to the Issuance by Oconee County of Industrial Revenue Bonds Pursuant to Title 4, Chapter 29, Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976 as Amended not to exceed \$8,000,000. Dr. Earle made a motion this resolution be adopted, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 4 - 0.


Rebecca Schmidt of Charity Medical presented to the Council an Energy Crisis Intervention Program, PA 80 financed under CAP Grant Number 40632 in the amount of \$6,438. Dr. Earle made a motion this program be accepted, seconded by Mr. Butts, Approved 4 - 0.

Mr. Brandt made a motion that \$1794 be taken from Contingency and be transferred to the Sheriff's Department for telephone expense, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 4 - 0.

Mr. Crain then stated it had cost the county approximately \$1600 for the special election held for the Council Seat in District 3. Dr. Earle made a motion that up to \$1600 be taken from Contingency to pay these expenses, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 4 - 0.

Mr. Crain read a letter which he and Mr. J. J. Hemphill, Seneca Magistrate had written to Mr. J. P. Strom, SLED asking him to look into the possibility that all revenue taken in by the Seneca Magistrate's Office has not been properly accounted for.
