

MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING, DECEMBER 1, 1981

The regular Oconee County Council Meeting was held December 1, 1981 at 7:00 P.M. in Council Chambers. All members were present except Mr. Butts.

Members of the press present: Steve Matthews - Greenville News, Cobb Oxford - Seneca Journal, Linda Jennings - Anderson Independent, & Ashton Hester - Keowee Courier.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Dr. Earle.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 3 - 0 to adopt the minutes of the November 17, 1981 meeting.

First on the agenda was a Public Hearing concerning the abandonment of an unused, unnumbered road running through lot 87A, Cherokee Gardens into property owned by Clemson University. There was on one present to comment on the abandonment of this road except Mr. John W. Fields, Attorney for the property owner who said the road was of no value to the property owners or the county.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 3 - 0 to adopt Resolution 81-15 to abandon this road.

Mr. Dan McFarlane of COG presented to Council a nine point plan to coordinate transportation for the Human Services Organizations in Oconee County.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 3 - 0 that Oconee County send a letter of endorsement of the Rural Transportation Plan in Oconee County to the governor of South Carolina.

Mr. Medford & Mr. Hunnicutt made a presentation as per attached on computer equipment.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 4 - 0 to sell seven pieces of unused computer equipment. Council determined it would be best to obtain the best prices possible on this equipment from known dealers.

Dr. Earle presented Ordinance 81-12, "Reapportionment" and made a motion that it be adopted on second reading. This motion was seconded by Mr. Harper and approved 4 - 0.

Mr. Crain presented Resolution 81-16, "Designating SHARE to Administer Oconee County's Community Service 1982 Block Grants"

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 4 - 0 to adopt this Resolution.

On September 15, 1981 Mr. Jim McCoy addressed Council on behalf of an Industrial Revenue Bond in the amount of \$3,000,000 for the expansion and equipment of the present Torrington Plant.

At that time Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Brandt, approved 5 - 0 that this contract be signed upon approval of the County Attorney.

Mr. Fedder stated that he had read the contract and everything was in order, this contract was adopted as Resolution 81-17.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Brandt, approved 4 - 0 that Rural Fire be allowed to purchase a 1982 Ford LTD from State Purchasing at a cost of \$8,544.88 plus tax.

Mr. Crain stated he had had numerous questions concerning the thirty (30) day limit in which employees had to take comp time. He asked the Intergovernmental Committee to look into this matter and make a recommendation to Council about strict adherence to this policy at the next meeting.

Mr. Crain read a letter from H. G. Pettit, Attorney for the town of West Union requesting that the Chief Magistrate take over the Recorder's duties for the Town of West Union. He asked Mr. Brandt's Committee to look into this matter.

Mr. Crain announced that this was the first day to take applications for energy assistance and we had a total of 78 applications. He also asked the news media to advertise that we would need an income documentation from applicants.

Mr. Crain read a letter from Gov. Riley stating that Oconee County's water line project had tentatively been approved in the amount of \$175,000. Final approval would depend on funds from Congress.
