

MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular Oconee County Council Meeting was held July 6, 1982 at 7:00 P.M. in Council Chambers with all members present.

Members of the press present: Dick Mangrum - WSNW Radio, Cobb Oxford - Seneca Journal, Dave Givens - Greenville News & Ashton Hester - Keowee Courier.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor - Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 to adopt the minutes of the June 15, 1982 meeting.

First on the agenda was a Public Hearing concerning Ordinance 82-6, "Acceptance of Roads in Subdivisions". Although there were several subdivision residents present there was no one who had either written or oral comments concerning the Ordinance.

Mrs. Roddey Stoudemire of the Library Board requested funds to upgrade a position which is presently open in the Library to a professional position.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 to give the Library \$2,000 with the understanding they could come back later and request a transfer of funds within their budget if this is not enough money for the type position desired by the Library. Dr. Earle also requested a job description for this position.

Mr. Frank Hix of SHARE requested that Agreement Number 45-69-903-9, "Summer Youth Feeding Program" be adopted by Council. The amount of the agreement is \$8,260.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Brandt, approved 5 - 0 that this program be adopted.

Mr. Medford, Assessor gave an update on the reassessment program. All the field work has been completed except just north of Seneca which will be completed by the end of the week. The business areas and towns have been completed and the assessment notices for them should be going out by the middle of August. The classification of land is not on schedule and Mr. Medford will be at the next Council Meeting to brief Council on this.

Dr. Earle presented an amendment to Ordinance 80-12, Ordinance 82-8, "Establishing Fees for Landfills" and made a motion that it be adopted in title only on first reading. This motion was seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0.

Mr. Butts presented Ordinance 82-7, "Acceptance of Roads Which are not in Subdivisions" and made a motion that it be adopted in title only on first reading. This motion was seconded by Dr. Earle and after discussion it was adopted 5 - 0.

Mr. Butts presented Ordinance 82-6, "Acceptance of Roads in Subdivisions" and made a motion that it be adopted on second reading. This motion was seconded by Mr. Williams and after much discussion was adopted 5 - 0.

After recommendation by the County Attorney, Dr. Earle made a motion that Resolution 82-7, "Inducement of Revenue Bonds for Torrington Mfg. Co." be adopted. This motion was seconded by Mr. Butts and approved 5 - 0.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 82-9, "Industrial Revenue Bonds for Torrington Mfg. Co." in the amount of \$3,000,000 be adopted on first reading in title only.

Dr. Earle made a motion that the Sheriff be allowed to transfer money within his department to change the following salaries:

04 11 06 1 (new employee) budgeted amount: 12,853 - change to 10,970

04 11 18 1 (deputy) budgeted amount: 11,058 - change to 11,580

04 11 19 1 (deputy) budgeted amount: 11,058 - change to 11,580.

This motion was seconded by Mr. Brandt, approved 5 - 0.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 to take \$20.70 from 1981-82 contingency for telephones in the Planning Commission.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 to take \$1200 from 1981-82 contingency to purchase phones for the Probation Office from Commtel and \$70 to move the phone for Voter Registration.

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Mr. Harper presented the bids for the pick up truck for Motor Pool and made a motion that Edwards Auto Sales be awarded the bid since they were low bidder at \$6760 including tax. This motion was seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0.

Mr. Harper presented the bids for the pick up truck for the Rock Crusher and made a motion that Edwards Auto Sales be awarded the bid since they were lot bidder at \$7462 including tax. This motion was seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0.

Mr. Harper presented the bids for drilling and blasting at the Rock Crusher and made a motion that Piedmont Engineers be awarded the bid at \$.64 a ton. This motion was seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0.

Mr. Harper presented the bids for the welder for the Rock Crusher and made a motion that Industrial Welding be awarded the bid at \$5950 plus tax. This motion was seconded by Mr. Butts with the stipulation that it be either a Miller or Lincoln welder, this motion was approved 5 - 0.

Mr. Harper presented the bids for the front end loader to be purchased jointly by the Supervisor's Office & CCS and made a motion that Van Lott be awarded the bid at \$107,952 including tax. This motion was seconded by Mr. Brandt, approved 5 - 0.

Dr. Earle made a motion that Doris V. Grant, Route 5, Box 101A, Westminster, S. C. 29693 be reappointed to the Human Resources Commission. The term is to expire December 31, 1985. This motion was seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0.

Mr. Crain announced the County would be advertising for an auditor for the 1982-83 fiscal year. He also announced the County would be advertising for a County Engineer for a one year period.
