

MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Oconee County Council was held July 19, 1983 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all members present.

Members of the press present: Sharon Lucas - Anderson Independent, Dave Givens - Greenville News, Glen Gannaway - Seneca Journal & Dick Mangrum - WSNW Radio.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Butts.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the July 5, 1983 meeting be adopted as printed.

Mr. Doyle Kay of the Anderson-Oconee Alcohol & Drug Abuse Commission addressed Council concerning the appointment of two commission members whose terms have expired. The Commission is recommending Mrs. Ethel M. Peterson & Mrs. Carolyn Garland for these appointments. Council agreed to take this matter into consideration.

Second reading of Ordinance 83-7, "An Ordinance to Identify all Roads in the Oconee County Road System" was postponed until after a public hearing announced to be held August 2, 1983 at 7:00 PM.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that O'Neal Engineering do engineering services for the county from August 1983 through August 1984.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that A. Joe McCall be awarded the bid for the county audit for fiscal year 1983-84. He was low bid at \$14,250.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Brandt, approved 5 - 0 that Bruce of Greenville be awarded the bid for a John Deere motor grader at \$49,917 and one Catapillar 12 motorgrader, serial number 8T20654 and one Catapillar 12E motorgrader, serial number 99E7532 to be traded in.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Brandt, approved 5 - 0 that Oconee County enter into a contract for engineering services with Sirrine Environmental Services for monitoring wells at the landfills at \$990.00.

Mr. Brandt made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. Glenn C. Martin, 306-A South Pine St., Walhalla, S. C. be appointed to replace Mr. Danny Edwards on the CCS Commission with his term expiring December 31, 1985.

Mr. Butts, Chairman of the Roads & Transportation Committee announced that the committee recommended the county deny maintenance on a road in Chauga Valley Subdivision as it is not and never has been a county road and would have to comply with Ordinance 82-7 before being accepted into the county road system.
