

MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held October 4, 1983 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all members present.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Brandt.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the September 20, 1983 meeting be adopted as printed.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Resolution 83-10, "A Resolution Authorizing an Inducement Contract Between Oconee County, South Carolina and Johnson Controls, Inc. Relating to the Issuance by Oconee County of Industrial Revenue Bonds (not to exceed \$10,000,000) Pursuant to Title 4, Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976 as Amended" be adopted on first and final reading.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that an Inducement Contract between Oconee County & Johnson Controls, Inc. as to Resolution 83-10 be adopted.
