MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held June 19, 1984 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all members present.

Members of the press present: Randall Holcombe - Seneca Journal, George Allgood - WGOG Radio & Mary McKenna - Greenville News.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Williams.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the June 5, 1984 meeting be adopted as printed.

Mr. Bob Winchester of the Sewer Commission presented to Council for approval the pretreatment standards for industries. Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0 these standards be adopted.

Next on the agenda was second reading or Ordinance 84-5, "Industrial Revenue Bonds for Steele Heddle Mfg. Co." in the amount of \$1,350,000. A public hearing concerning these bonds had been advertised by the Lawfirm of Wyche, Burgess, Freeman & Parham and Mr. Carl Muller of Steele Heddle was present to answer any questions anyone might have. There was no one present with written or oral comments concerning these bonds.

Mr. Brandt made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 84-5 be adopted on second reading.

Mr. Brandt reported that he had received no recommendations from the municipilities on the bingo ordinance they requested at an earlier committee meeting and also he would like to have a Law Enforcement Committee Meeting in the near future to discuss the new policies for LEC.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 to accept the bid of Vector Corporation to repair the roof at the courthouse in the amount of \$21,990, to take \$1,990 from contingency for covering the roof, \$3,790 from contingency to drain the roof and \$1,000 from contingency for architectural fees.
