

MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held February 19, 1985 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all members present.

The Invocation was given by Mr. Dyar.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the February 5, 1985 meeting be adopted as printed.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Resolution 85-7, "A Resolution Authorizing An Inducement Contract Between Oconee County South Carolina & Piedmont Quilting Relating To the Issuance By Oconee County Of Industrial Revenue Bonds (Not to exceed \$1,500,000) Pursuant To Title 4, Code Of Laws Of South Carolina, 1976 As Amended" be adopted on first and final reading.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the Inducement Contract between Oconee County & Piedmont Quilting as to Resolution 85-7 be adopted.

Mr. Mizer of Piedmont Quilting, Mr. Jim Williams, Attorney for Piedmont Quilting and Attorney Mr. Jim Pressley were present for the meeting.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the attached rule changes for Rural Fire in which all departments must have their inspection reports in ten (10) days after due date and all equipment must be inventoried annually, this is not in lieu of inventory required by the county.

Mr. Crain referred the request of the Magistrate's Office for more phones to the Law Enforcement Committee.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. Medford be allowed to exchange an IBM Personal Computer as per attached letter in conjunction with contract with Smith Data. The cost of the computer is \$7,200 with a trade in allowance of \$2,200 - the actual cost to the county will be \$5,000.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5 - 0 that the attached arts contract be adopted.

Mr. Crain referred a request from the Solicitor's Office for more space to the Building & Grounds Committee.

Mr. Crain referred to the Personnel & Intergovernmental Committee the responsibility of making a recommendation to County Council concerning the fact there is no provision in the County Ordinances creating commissions to remove a member for any reason whatsoever other than not attending meetings.

Commissions

Mr. Fedder, County Attorney, asked Council to consider a private conference room for attorneys and clients because there is no place at the courthouse except the hallways for them to discuss pending cases.

Space

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Council adopt Resolution 85-8, "A Resolution Supporting the Continuation of Federal Revenue Sharing Funds" on on first and final reading.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 4 - 1 (Mr. Butts voting against) that \$161.25 plus tax and \$37.45 plus tax be taken from contingency to install and pay the monthly rate of a pay phone at the courthouse.

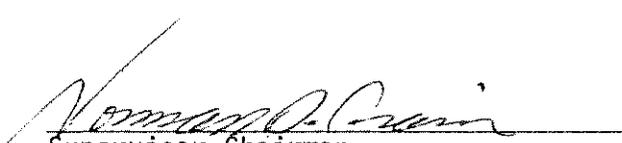
Mr. Crain referred to the Law Enforcement Committee the Summer Youth Food Program to make a recommendation to Council whether we should continue to participate in it.
