MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, December 3, 1985 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all members present.

Members of the press notified (in writing): Seneca Journal, Keowee Courier, Greenville News, Anderson Independent, WGOG Radio & WSNW Radio.

Members of the press present: Randall Holcombe -Seneca Journal, Dale Perry - Greenville News, Ed Miller - Anderson Independent, Dick Mangrum - WGOG Radio, Dave Partenheimer - WSNW Radio & Ashton Hester - Keowee Courier.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Butts.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5-0 that the minutes of the November 19, 1985 meeting be adopted as printed.

First on the agenda was a public hearing concerning the issuance of industrial revenue bonds in the amount of \$1,000,000 and the issuance of pollution control bonds in the amount of \$5,500,000 for Englehard Corporation. There was no one present with written and/or oral comments for these hearings.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 to adopted Resolution 85-22, "A Resolution Confirming That A Public Hearing Was Held Concerning the Bonds for Englehard and also Giving the Supervisor-Chairman Authority to Sign the Englehard Bonds".

Next on the agenda was a public hearing concerning closing approximately five hundred (500) feet of county roadway CE 44, Mr. Dyar, Chairman of the Road Committee, informed Council that it was the recommendation that this section of CE 44 be closed as it was the request of the property owners in that area. There was no one present with oral comments concerning the closing of the roadway, Mr. Crain did read the attached petition signed by the property owners.

Mr. Kenneth Williams, Auditor and Mrs. Madge Robison, Tax Collector, addressed Council concerning the county collecting delinquent taxes for the municipalities under the Uniform Tax Collection Law. After discussion it was agreed by consensus that the county attorney draw up a contract between the municipalities and the county for the collection of delinquent taxes to include the following:

- 1) The county enter into a contract to collect taxes for the municipalities
- 2) The county keep all penalties and execution fees on these delinquent taxes

- 3) The cities will assist the tax collector in executing these cases inside the city limits with city police upon request of the tax collector
- 4) The county needs to contract with the municipalities prior to March 15
- 5) The county needs to decide upon a cost to the cities, but try for a while keeping the penalties and execution cost in lieu of a fee, also continue Smith Data billing their costs directly to the municipalities

Mrs. Robinson made a request for additional office space and equipment, Mr. Crain referred this request to the Buildings & Grounds Committee.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5-0 that the cost of gravel be adjusted January 1, 1986 as per attached list.

Upon recommendation of Texidyne Engineering and Mr. Bob Winchester of the Oconee Sewer Commission, Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar that Alexander & Associates be awarded the bid to install the sewer line for the Richland Creek Project at a cost of \$134,310.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 85-12, "Industrial Revenue Bond Ordinance for Englehard Corporation" in the amount of \$1,000,000 be adopted on third and final reading.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 85-14, "Pollution Control Bond Ordinance for Englehard Corporation" as amended in the amount of \$5,500,000 be adopted on third and final reading.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that Mr. Jack Kell be reappointed to the Rural Fire Commission with his term commencing January 1, 1986 and expiring January 1, 1990.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5-0 that Mr. Dewitt Mize be reappointed to the Rural Fire Commission with his term commencing January 1, 1986 and expiring January 1, 1990.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that a parking lot for county employees be made on the lot where the old jail used to be. The county will consider paving the lot at a later date.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5-0 that one optional holiday be done away with and the day after Christmas be given to county employees.

Mr. Crain announced a public hearing to be held December 9, 1985 at 6:00 PM in Council Chambers concerning CDBG Funds for the purpose of receiving public imput on public facilities, community needs and public housing.
