## MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, April 15, 1986 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all members present.

Members of the press notified (by mail): Seneca Journal, Keowee Courier, Greenville News, Anderson Independent, WGOG Radio, WSNW Radio & WCCP Radio.

Members of the press present: Dave Partenheimer - Seneca Journal, Tammy Tucker - WCCP Radio & Mike Petrovsky - Seneca Journal.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Dyar.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the April 1, 1986 meeting be adopted as printed.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that the bid for road paving for the 1985-86 fiscal year be awarded to Sloan Construction who was low bid as per the attached bid listing.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 4-1 (Mr. Dyar voting against) that the motion to purchase the vehicles for the Sheriff's Department through Edward's Auto Sales be rescinded due to the body molding being left off the specifications and it would take an additional \$362.81 for this body molding and the vehicles be purchased through state purchasing.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that the campers at all county parks who have paid through the winter months be allowed to stay until October 1, 1986. The rates will remain unchanged through June 30, 1986, beginning July 1, 1986 the rates will be \$120 per month plus \$3 for day and/or night occupancy through September 30, 1986. On or before October 1, 1986 the campers must move, the rule that campers be allowed to remain at one camp site no longer than thirty (30) days will then be enforced. The park rules will have to be adhered to concerning patios, shubbery, etc. This policy will apply to present campers as well as anyone wishing to camp at the county parks.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that \$973.20 be taken from contingency and placed in line item number 10 049 00110 04913 to pay an employee in the CCS Department who will be temporarily replacing an employee who is on extended sick leave.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfers be approved.

Mr. Crain on behalf of the County Council congratulated Dr. Earle on being elected Chairman of the Appalachian Council of Governments.

Mr. Crain addressed Council concerning the enhanced 911 service for the county. Council deemed it wise to meet with representatives of Southern Bell to discuss this plan April 22, 1986 at 6:00 PM in Council Chambers.

Mr. Crain on behalf of the Chairman of the Planning & Development Board requested Council go into executive session for an administrative briefing.

When Council went back into open session Mr. Crain announced that Mr. Gaillard, Planning Director & Mr. Bob Winchester, Sewer Commission Director and he had informed Council that a poultry processing plant is interested in locating in Oconee County, there were concerns about odor generated from such a plant and the amount of sewer and water needed for such a plant.

Mr. Crain announced that Council agreed to invite the Poultry Association to the next County Council Meeting to hear their views on this matter.
