MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, May 6, 1986 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all members present.

Members of the press notified (by mail): Seneca Journal, Keowee Courier, Greenville News, Anderson Independent, WGOG Radio & WCCP Radio.

Members of the press present: Tammy Tucker - WCCP Radio, Chris Hummer - WGOG Radio, Dave Partenheimer - WSNW Radio, Brad King - Seneca Journal & Ashton Hester - Keowee Courier.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Butts.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, that the minutes of the April 15, 1986 meeting be approved. Mr. Williams made a motion that paragraph eight read: Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 4 - 1 (Mr. Dyar voting against) to purchase the vehicles for the Sheriff's Department through Edward's Auto Sales be rescinded due to the body molding being left off the specifications and it would take an additional \$362.81 for this body molding and the vehicles be purchased through state purchasing.

Both the amendment and the motion were adopted 5 - 0.

Mr. Derrill Ables, President of the Oconee Poultry Association, informed Council that the Poultry Industry that had been negotiating with Oconee County is no longer interested in locating in Oconee County.

Mr. Tony Adams commended Council on the professional manner in which Oconee County had handled this and other industrial negotiations.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - O that Crown Ford be awarded the bid for a fourteen (14) cubic yard tandem dump truck at the cost of \$56,980.90.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - O that Powell Brothers be awarded the bid for a sixty horse power tractor, model number 5610 with a rotary mower attachment at the cost of \$23,077.95.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that Oconee Implement be awarded the bid for a 9-ton "BEE" trailer at a cost of \$4,725 with trade in.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - O that the attached contract between the Oconee County Sheriff's Department and US Department of Agriculture, Forest

Dr. Earle informed Council that Anderson & Pickens Counties have not at this time taken a position on the proposed Jobs Training Partnership Act as presented by Mr. Larry Inabinet.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - O that, on the recommendation of the City of Seneca, Mr. Devoe Blackston be appointed to replace Mrs. Sallie Owen as a member of the Sewer Commission.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that \$1,019.72 be taken from contingency and be placed in line item 10 058 00150 00025, Planning Commission Professional, for a preliminary study of the Perkins Creek Lift Station.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that \$10.50 be taken from contingency and placed in line item number 10 057 00150 00031 to replace a check written in 1984 which had been lost and voided. This is to pay for three service directories for the Health Department.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfers be approved.

Dr. Earle informed Council that PRT wants to hire the "Sound of Country" band to perform on Saturday Nights at Chau Ram County Park. It was decided this would be discussed at the Committee Meeting, May 8, 1986.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 to enter into a ninety (90) day option with the Richardson Family at a cost of \$1,000 to purchase the property across from the airport on the Shiloh Road in order to obtain air rights.

Mr. Crain informed Council that a time capsule with memorabilia from the 1968 centennial had been placed in a capsule and was to have been buried at that time. However, it has not been buried as of this date. Mr. Crain referred this to the Building & Grounds Committee.

The Intergovernmental Committee set a meeting for Tuesday May 13, 1986 at 6:00 PM in Council Chambers to discuss an acceptable proof of sewage disposal before a building permit can be issued.
