

MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, July 1, 1986 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present. Supervisor-Chairman Crain was absent due to illness and Vice Chairman Butts presided over the meeting.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Butts who welcomed the guests and media.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Butts acting as Chairman) that the minutes of the June 17, 1986 meeting be adopted as printed.

Ms. Wilene Schumpert addressed Council concerning the funding of the all day kindergarten. After a lengthy discussion in which Council informed Ms. Schumpert they could not dictate to the School Department how to spend their funds and also the all day kindergarten originated as a federally funded project which has now been abandoned by the federal government, Mr. Brandt, County Attorney pointed out to Ms. Schumpert that since the 1986-1987 county budget had already been placed into operation it would take a supplemental appropriations ordinance with three readings and a public hearing before these funds could be appropriated if the county felt the funds could be made available.

Mrs. Ann Hoshall, School Board Member, also addressed Council, she informed Council that the School Department has approximately \$500,000 in the fund balance and it would basically wipe out this fund balance to fund the all day kindergarten.

According to Ms. Schumpert it will take approximately \$166,000 to fund the all day kindergarten.

Mr. Butts and Council expressed their appreciation to Ms. Schumpert and Mrs. Hoshall for coming to the meeting and assured them they too, are interested in the children in Oconee County.

Dr. Earle informed Council that one of the heirs of the Richardson property - located across Shiloh Road from the County's airport which the county is negotiating to purchase - is now deceased and the County Attorney is attempting to work out the details.

It was the consensus of Council that the Intergovernmental Committee work out the details and operation of the vending machines in county buildings and the canteen at the courthouse.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Butts acting as Chairman) that the Deputy Auditor's classification be changed from 14B to 18B, costing about \$225 plus fringe to be taken from contingency.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Butts acting as Chairman) that the attached "Agreement of Cooperation" between Department of Social Services and Oconee County concerning child support be adopted.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Butts acting as Chairman) that up to ninety days sick leave be approved for Bette Grambrell in the Probate Judge's Office who was in a serious automobile accident. Mrs. Gambrell will have twenty one days vacation and sick leave that she is due to be paid and the balance of the leave will be without pay.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Butts acting as Chairman) that the Probate Judge be allowed to hire someone for a two week period and advertise the position of Temporary Secretary for someone to fill in for Mrs. Gambrell while she is out on leave.

Dr. Earle requested and it was agreed by general consensus that the fee schedule for opening the gate early and late be referred back to the PRT Commission for review and reconsideration.


