

MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, November 18, 1986 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

Press

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Dyar.

Invocation

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the October 21, 1986 meeting be adopted as printed.

Minutes

At the request of Mr. J. W. Ballenger, Probate Judge and Mrs. Sandra Burgess, Probate Judge Elect, Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that \$1,350 be taken from contingency and placed in line item 10 023 00150 00018, out of county travel, for the Probate Judge's Office. These funds will be used to attend meetings, etc.

Contingency

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that Davis Brothers be awarded the bid for the timber near the hospital, they were high bid at \$6,470.01.

Timber Bid

Mrs. Marianne Dillard, Purchasing Director, informed Council that as of February 1, 1987 the county will be required to have all insurance coverage for buildings, tort, auto and inland marine with a private insurance carrier or with the state. She also informed Council she had sent letters to all agencies in the area to determine if there would be enough interest to warrant putting it out for bids.

Insurance Coverage

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that Resolution 86-10, "A Resolution Making Application to the State Budget & Control Board of South Carolina for approval of the issuance by Oconee County, South Carolina, of its Industrial Revenue Note (The Jacobs Manufacturing Company Project) 1986 pursuant to the provisions of South Carolina Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 29, (1986) as amended in the principal amount of not exceeding \$2,500,000 be adopted on first and final reading.

Res. 86-10

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that Resolution 86-11, "A Resolution Making Application to the State Budget & Control Board of South Carolina for approval of the issuance by Oconee County, South Carolina, of its Industrial Development Revenue Note (Log Cabin Furniture Co, Inc. Project) 1986 Pursuant to the provisions of South Carolina Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 29 (1976), As Amended, In the principal amount of not exceeding \$2,000,000" be adopted on first and final reading.

Res. 86-11

The Honorable Tommy Powell, Mayor of Salem, addressed Council concerning their support for a sewer system to Salem. After considerable discussion in which Mr. Sam Cargill, Representative of COG, informed Council & Mr. Powell that grants are 50/50 match and very competitive and also, low and moderate income families would have to be connected to such a sewer line at no cost to the home owner; also a definite need for such a system would have to be established. Council assured Mr. Powell they are willing to work with Salem in any way possible.

Sewer for Salem

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that one full time temporary Secretary II be authorized for the Magistrate's Office to be paid from line item 10 060 00110 06003, while the regular employee is out on sick leave and one full time temporary secretary III be authorized for the Magistrate's Office to be paid from line item 10 060 00110 006004, until a ministerial magistrate is appointed. Also the part time employee is authorized to work additional hours and be paid from line item 10 060 00110 06004.

Help for Magistrate

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that a proposal by Duke Power Company be approved in principal for the improvement of County Roadway KE 13. Duke Power will submit a contract for approval at a later date.

KE 13

Mr. Wally Dost addressed Council concerning keeping the Lunney Museum open. After considerable discussion, Mr. Dyar made a motion that a museum assistant be hired for a three month period for the Lunney Museum with funds (up to \$1,600) coming from line item 10 001 00100 73600. After discussion, Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper that the motion be amended to four months rather than three months. This motion as amended was adopted 5 - 0.

Lunney Museum

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that \$1,066.50 plus tax be taken from contingency for an NDBA monitor for the airport as to attached proposal.

Contingency

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. M. D. Clayton's resignation as a member of the Emergency Preparedness Commission be accepted and he be sent a letter of appreciation.

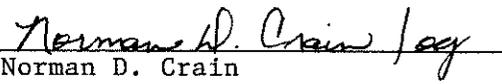
Emergency Preparedness
