

MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, April 7, 1987 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the March 17, 1987 meeting be adopted as printed.

Mr. Jimmy DuPre, Superintendent of Education, Mr. Jim Bridges and the Oconee County School Board - Mr. Charlie Johnson, Mr. John McKnight, Mr. James G. Brown, Mr. Jerry Lee, Dr. Harry Mays, Mrs. Ann Hoshall & Mr. James Myers presented the attached proposed school budget to Council.

School Budget

Dr. Harry Mays asked that Council make every effort to fund the budget.

After much discussion Mr. Crain referred this budget request to the Budget & Finance Committee.

Mr. Steve Leslie, Chairman of the Alliance for Improved Education in Oconee County, supported the School District's request.

After considerable discussion, Mr. Crain thanked him for coming and assured them they would be notified and invited to attend the budget committee meetings.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 87-3, "An Ordinance Repealing Ordinance 75-5 & Abolishing Oconee County Mental Retardation Board (Creation of) Duties & Responsibilities" be adopted on third and final reading. This is now a state responsibility.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 87-5, "The 1986-87 Supplemental Appropriation Ordinance" be approved on second reading.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 3 - 2 (Mr. Butts & Mr. Williams voting against) that Oconee County accept 350,000 gallons of slightly radionuclide material at the Coneross Treatment Facility with an appropriate monitoring agency as determined by Oconee County present to monitor the sludge at regulated intervals at Duke Power's expense.

Dr. Earle, Chairman of the Personnel Committee, announced there would be a meeting of the Personnel Committee April 16, 1987 at 6:30 PM in Council Chambers to discuss the COG study in detail.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that the county continue with the plans for a portable building to be used for office space, that this building be built under a management construction plan waiving the bid procedure and that three (3) oral bids for each sub contractor be obtained. This plan is for this building only.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfers be approved.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that the Clerk of Court be allowed to hire a temporary employee for eight (8) weeks at a cost of \$2,065.65 to replace a permanent employee who will be out on sick leave.


Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that the attached arts contracts be approved.
