

MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, August 18, 1987 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members present.

Members of the press notified (by mail): Seneca Journal, Keowee Courier, Greenville News, Anderson Independent, The Oconee Leader, WGOG Radio, WSNW Radio, WCCP Radio, WYFF TV & WLOS TV.

Press

Members of the press present: Dave Partenheimer - WSNW Radio, Dick Mangrum - WGOG Radio, Cindy Landrum - The Oconee Leader & Beth Lowery - Seneca Journal.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor- Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Butts.

Invocation

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Harper abstaining) that the minutes of the August 4, 1987 meeting be adopted as printed.

Minutes

At the recommendation of Mr. Kenneth Williams, County Auditor, Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 4 - 1 (Mr. Butts voting against) that the county millage for fiscal year 1987-88 be set at 132 mils. This is an increase of eight (8) mils over last year, this gives the county forty (40) mils and the school ninety and one quarter (90.25) mils. Tri County will receive one and three quarters (1.75) mils. The School Department receives an increase of five (5) mils and the county three (3) mils.

Millage

Mr. Butts asked that it be made a part of the record that he could not support the millage increase because he could not support the budget.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 87-8, "Oconee County Animal Control Act & Repeal of Ordinance 78-4" be adopted in title only.

Ord. 87-8

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 87-4, "Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance" be adopted on third and final reading.

Ord. 87-4

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. Clarence Kay be awarded a one (1) year lease on the rental property at the airport (both buildings) at \$300 per month and that \$300 be taken from contingency to replace the carpet in the living room of the brick dwelling.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that the contract with Southern Bell advanced Systems, Inc. for the Essx Telephone System be amended to include six (6) lines and six (6) phones in the EOC Office which will cost \$1,050 to install and \$200 per month thereafter to be paid for from Duke Power F & F Funds. These lines will then be usable all year instead of only during the drills.

Addendum

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Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle that the Purchasing Agent and a mechanic be permitted to go to the State Surplus Auction to bid on a vehicle for county use.

State Auction

After discussion, Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 to amend the motion to take \$3,000 from contingency to allow the Purchasing Agent to purchase the best vehicle possible for that amount of money (including the \$2,000 already in the budget).

Contingency

The motion as amended was also approved 5 - 0.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the attached arts contract be approved.

Arts Contract





Mr. Crain suggested that one employee work as a heavy equipment operator half time to do this and then work half time as a light equipment operator. He further informed Council the Comptroller would have some cost figures on this at the next Council Meeting.

- C. The APT reserves the right to refuse to perform outdoor engagements when, in the APT's judgement, weather conditions would be detrimental to its members and/or equipment.
- D. Failure of the SPONSOR to comply with the terms of this contract as stated herein, including cancellation, will represent breach of contract and will result in liquidating damages in the amount of 100% of the agreed performance fee.
