

MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, October 18, 1988 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members present and the County Attorney coming in late.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

Meeting

The invocation was given by Dr. Earle.

Invocation

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the October 4, 1988 meeting be adopted as printed.

Minutes

Mr. Robert Gaillard addressed Council concerning funding for a sewer line in the Corinth Community in Seneca for Intergrated Support Systems, Inc., Mr. Gaillard asked for permission to seek funding in the amount of \$231,000 with half coming from ARC funds and half from SC State funds. The expansion of the plant would also mean some twenty-five (25) to thirty (30) new jobs in Oconee County.

Sewer Grant

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. Gaillard's request be granted.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that ADB Alnaco, Inc. be awarded the bid for runway lights at the airport at a cost of \$5,808. (See attached bid)

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0 that Oconee County enter into a contract with Business Records Corporation for the re-creation of records in the Probate Judge's Office. Business Records Corporation is a sole source for this service. (See attachment)

Mr. Crain informed Council he had received a letter from Lexington County informing him they had contracted their garbage pick up service and had some five hundred (500) green boxes and seven (7) trucks for sale to the highest bidder. Mr. Crain further informed Council there was one truck that could be best used by Oconee County, a 1985 LNT 9000 with 102,000 miles on it.

CCS

After some discussion, Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 4 - 1 (Mr. Dyar voting against) to bid \$12,000 on the truck, \$12,500 on the boxes with a transportation cost of \$5,800 (based on 500 boxes) for a total cost of \$30,000 \$22,000 can come from the CCS budget and the remaining \$8,300 will have to come from contingency.

Mr. Fant Honea, Rural Fire Marshal, on behalf of the Rural Fire Commission, recommended to Council that a demonstrator Grumman Fire Truck with 9,298 miles on it be purchased for the county.

Fire Truck

After much discussion in which all commission members present stated they supported the purchase of the Grumman truck and it was a much better built truck than the LTI truck, Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that a new Grumman truck be purchased at a cost of \$443,611 plus \$1,100 for an extended warranty. (See attached bid)

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0 that the employment of a temporary secretary in the Magistrate's Office be extended until a part time magistrate is appointed with the salary coming from that slot.

Magistrate

Mr. Crain referred the request of the Clerk of Court for a burglar alarm system for the court house, especially the Clerk of Court & Family Court to the Building & Grounds Committee.

Alarm System

After discussion, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that council apply for a federal grant in the amount of \$370,000 and commit to 20% of the funding to replace the Jenkins Bridge which has been closed by the South Carolina Highway Department.

Jenkins

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that approximately \$180 be taken from contingency to move the phones at the landfills closer to the work sites in the landfills and also a \$120 monthly for portable toilets to be used at the landfills.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the following persons be reappointed as Alcohol & Drug Abuse Commission Members:

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Mr. Williams, Chairman of the Building & Grounds Committee, made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the Seneca Health Clinic be allowed to use the portion of the building the clinic is now in which was formerly used by Home Health Services.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that Oconee County purchase a roofer's kettle and the supplies to repair the cracks in the parking area at the airport.

Mr. Roger Williams, Assessor, informed Council he had received quite a few agricultural land use forms, he would set them up into categories of sickness, etc and Council could go over them for approval or disapproval at a later date.
