MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, March 7, 1989 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and Mr. Jerry Fedder, Attorney, present.

All other persons who have asked to be notified of meetings were also notified by mail.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Stone.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the February 21, 1989 meeting be adopted as printed.

First on the agenda was a public hearing to receive written and/or oral comments regarding the 1988-89 supplemental appropriation ordinance. There was no one present with either written and/or oral comments.

Next on the agenda Mr. Keith Shuler was scheduled to address Council regarding the requirements for Superintendent of Education. However, before Mr. Shuler spoke, Mr. Fedder advised Council the only authority Council had in this matter was the setting of millage to fund the schools and such requirements are set by the legislature. The Council, as a body politic, has no input into these requirements.

Mr. Shuler urged Council to check into the situation and see what the people would like to have done.

After discussion, Mr. Crain referred this matter to the Intergovernmental Committee to make a recommendation to Council as to the action Council should take, if any, regarding the matter.

Mr. William Rowell of DHEC addressed Council regarding the ban of lead solder flux and pipe in the drinking water industry. Mr. Rowell urged Council to adopt a building code such as the Southern Building Code in Oconee County to protect citizens from health damages that can be caused by lead in drinking water.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 89-1, "An Ordinance for the Identification of Fire Hazardous Materials" be adopted on third and final reading.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 89-2, "1988-89 Supplemental Appropriation Ordinance" be adopted on third and final reading.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Council have a public hearing, Thursday, April 6, 1989 at 7:00 PM in the courtroom regarding the proposed adoption of building codes in Oconee County.

Mr. Crain informed Council it would cost \$925 per three foot section and \$150 each to have Delta Surface mount traffic controller sections at South Cove Park, however the salesman was unable to give the cost of the signs needed and would get back with Mr. Crain the next day.

Mr. Strickland would like to have these installed so fisherman and campers could get out of the park after 10:00 PM but no one could get in because of the design of the traffic controllers.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfers be approved.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that \$933 be taken from contingency and placed in line item number 10 058 00110 05801 to pay the Administrative Assistant for vacation pay when she retires at the end of March, 1989.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - O that Resolution 89-1, "A Resolution Designating Anderson-Oconee Council on Aging as an Entity to Provide Transportation for Elderly and/or Handicapped Persons" in Oconee County be approved on first and final reading.

* Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - O that the purchasing procedure be waived and North Brothers, Inc. (sole source) reroof the DSS Building and the Health Building with urethane foam.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that Motor Pool be allowed to spend a total of \$7,400 to repair the rock truck at the Rock Crusher.
