## MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, June 20, 1989 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

All other persons who have asked to be notified of meetings were also notified by mail.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Dyar.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5-0 that the minutes of the June 6, 1989 meeting be adopted as printed.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, that the minutes of the "Reconvening of the June 6, 1989 Meeting" be adopted as printed.

Mr. Harper requested that the word "Magistrate" be added to the second paragraph from the bottom on the first page regarding the temporary part time (30 hr. per week person) being made a permanent position.

At the request of Mr. Robert Winchester, Sewer Commission Director, and Mr. Diggs Hill of Farmer's Home Administration, Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the attached letter of conditions from Farmer's Home be adopted for the sewer line to serve ISS Industries.

Mr. Kenneth Hackmann, Mr. James Beard & Mr. Robert Buse of Keep Oconee Beautiful addressed Council regarding improving the green box sites. KOBA would like to see sites C-19 and D-6 paved, they would also like to see the sites closed in with plants or fencing, and Duke Power will provide lighting for \$4.50 per month. At their request, Mr. Strickland, Chairman of the Law Enforcement, Safety, Health, Welfare & Services will be meeting with them in the near future to discuss proposed improvements for the green box sites.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the low bid of Overholt Construction at \$5581. 25 be accepted for a retainer wall on County Roadway SE 118 be accepted.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that Resolution 89-4, "A Resolution Regarding the Acceptance of the Lease with Southern National Leasing Company for the Firetruck" be adopted on first and final reading.

There was a \$100 error made in the funding for the lease of the firetruck, Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 4-0 (Mr. Strickland out of room) that this \$100 be taken from contingency.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5-0 that the request of the Chairman of the Board of Registration's part time hourly salary be raised \$1.00 as per attached request and these funds come from part time salary in that department with no additional funds allotted.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that the attached transfers be approved.

Mr. Stone made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that no restrictions be placed on the coroner's use of the vehicle which he will receive at the first of the fiscal year. This will be a deputy vehicle that is turned back in, and Mr. Durham, Coroner, assured Council it would be used for county business only.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that \$285 be taken from contingency and placed in  $10\ 016\ 00150\ 00041$ , Solicitor telephone for the remainder of the fiscal year.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that \$1,200 be taken from contingency and placed in 10 012 00200 02005, Rural Fire vehicle maintenance for unexpected expenses that have been incurred.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Council accept with reluctance Ms. Melinda Makasymowicz resignation from the Arts & Historical Commission and she be appointed to replace Mrs. Roddey Stoudemire on the Library Board whose term expires June 30, 1989 and she is not eligible to be reappointed.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5-0 that a SHARE worker for the Library be approved as per attached request.

Dr. Earle informed Council that the Keowee District has now been divided into two (2) precincts.

Mr. Crain informed Council of a request from an individual who has adopted a dog at the Animal Shelter to have this dog replaced due to the fact the dog was ran over and killed before he carried it to the vet.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, that the county adhere to the animal control policy.

Mr. Crain informed Council that the City of Seneca was going to accept the aerial ladder platform truck and it was the consensus of Council that the county do the work necessary on the fire station driveway with a letter from the City of Seneca outlining the work the are requesting be done.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5 - 0 that the person who donated the miniature golf course to be set up at South Cove Park be given a receipt in the amount of \$8,500 as this is the estimated value of the course.

Council scheduled a work session Wednesday, June 21, 1989 at 2:00 PM in Council Chambers to discuss the classification & compensation study.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5-0 that the attached lease agreement between the City of Seneca and Oconee County be approved.

Mr. Crain informed Council that Mr. Calvin Blackwell's wife passed away on Sunday, they would be receiving friends that night and the funeral would be Wednesday at 2:00 PM.

Mr. Crain also informed County that the Tribble Center had presented Council with a plaque in appreciation for all Council had done for them.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that a letter of reprimand be placed in the Animal Control Director's personnel file to the effect that any other infraction would result in dismissal.
