MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, August 15, 1989 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members present.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the August 1, 1989 meeting be adopted as printed.

Mr. Walt Purcell, Emergency Preparedness Director, gave Council an update on emergency preparedness activities including informing Council there will be a testing of the sirens August 26, 1989 at 9:00 AM and also a simulated table top exercise at Engelhard, Seneca, S. C., August 23, 1989.

Mr. Stone made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfer for the Treasurer's Office to build some cabinets be approved.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfer to purchase a vacuum cleaner for the main library be approved.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfer for the Sheriff's Department (Communications) be approved due to one of the secretaries going to have to be out on sick leave.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that \$4,200 for sixty (60) tapes and \$450 for an eraser for these tapes be taken from contingency and placed in line item number 10 031 00150 31841, operational, for these expenditures.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 4-0 (Mr. Strickland out of room) that the attached written procedures be adopted for computer selection of jurors for Magistrate trials.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5-0 that the attached option to purchase twenty (20) acres of land adjacent to the Rock Crusher be approved.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5-0 that Piedmont Explosives be awarded the bid for drilling and blasting at the Rock Crusher at \$.55 per ton.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that L. B. Smith, Inc. be awarded the bid for an off road truck/backdump (Euclid R-35) at a cost of \$186,545 including an extended warranty.

The Purchasing, Contracting, Real Estate, Building & Grounds Committee scheduled a meeting Tuesday, September 5, 1989 at 5:30 PM in Council Chambers for the purpose of discussing the costs of renovating the Tax Center to construct an office for the Delinquent Tax Collector, a storage area under the stairwell and a canteen area for the employees as well as discussing recocommendation of members for the Building Code Steering Committee.

Dr. Earle informed Council he did have samples of junkyard ordinances and he felt this should be done in conjunction with CCS.

Council asked Dr. Earle to research the request of Anderson Memorial Hospital to develop the old Williamston Hospital into an alcohol and substance abuse facility and make a recommendation concerning Council's endorsement.
