MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, January 16, 1990 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

Other Persons

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

Call to Order

The invocation was given by Mr. Dyar.

Invocation

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the January 2, 1990 meeting be adopted as printed.

Minutes

Ms. Lucy Murr and Ms. Wanda Benson of the Probation and Parole updated Council on the work being done in their offices. They informed Council that in Oconee County they have 491 clients, have done 147 investigations and in 1989 their office issued fifty-two (52) citations. Their office collected \$70,000 in fines during 1989 and in the month of December their office collected \$5,722. Some of their programs include intensive supervision, home detention, shop probation, restitution center and public service employment for non violent offenders.

Probation Parole

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that the Health Department's request for one (1) more phone line and two (2) more phones be denied and the Health Department ask DHEC to install the phones.

Health Dept.

Mr. Harper asked that if DHEC turned the request down, Council be given a copy of the denial in writing.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 4 - 1 (Mr. Harper voting against) to adopt the concept of a company placing a copying machine in the Walhalla and Seneca branches of the Oconee County Library System at no cost to the county with the company providing all supplies and the company receiving the proceeds from the machines at \$.10 per copy.

Copier for Library

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfer for PRT be approved.

PRT Transfer

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. Donald Reid's bid for the outbuildings at the airport at \$125 be accepted. (See attached bid)

Airport

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfer transferring \$14,000 from insurance into Motor Pool professional for the purpose of paying for testing and providing a monitoring system and disposing of contaminated materials.

Motor Pool

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. Barry Earnhardt's request for an extension to file for the agricultural land use be denied. (See attachments)

Land Use

The Building & Grounds Committee scheduled a meeting Tuesday, January 23, 1990 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers for the purpose of further review and discussion of the proposed plans for the Veterans Affairs Office and other building matters.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. Robert Gaillard and Mrs. Lucille Battle be reappointed to the Board of the South Carolina Appalachian Council of Governments. The terms are for two (2) years and will expire January, 1992.

COG Appts.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. Tom Petty be reappointed to the Sewer Commission representing the City of Seneca, his term is to commence immediately and expire December 31, 1993.

Sewer Appts.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. John Durham be reappointed to the Sewer Commission as an at large member with his term commencing immediately and expiring December 31, 1993.

Mr. Stone made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the following commission appointments be made with their term commencing immediately and expiring December 31, 1993.
