MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, March 6, 1990 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the February 20, 1990 meeting be adopted as printed.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfer for the purchase of a fuel truck for the Aeronautics Commission be approved.
