MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, December 18, 1990 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

All other persons who have asked to be notified of meetings were also notified by mail.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

At the request of Mr. Tommy Crumpton, Rock Crusher Director, Mr. Stone made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the rock crusher be allowed to purchase an update for their computer that will do a monthly sales analysis, tally accounts receivable, etc. as requested by the auditors for a total cost of \$3,200. (See attachment)

At the request of Mr. Jim Smith, Public Buildings Director, Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that \$684 be taken from contingency and placed in line item number 10 026 00840 26841 to purchase a dumpster and \$200 for a fence to put around the dumpster.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that Texidyne, Inc. be awarded the bid for sampling and analyzing the groundwater at the landfills for the last quarter only at a total cost of \$5,940. (See attached bid)

Council voted unanimously to award the bid for a roll-off truck, compactor and hoist to Amick Equipment Company at a total cost of \$100,093. (See attached bid)

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5-0 that Jack J. Arnold be awarded the bid for rental of the pasture land at \$650 per year and the cultivated land at \$100 per year. (See attached bid)

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5-0 that \$15,000 be taken from contingency to purchase fuel to fill the tanks at the airport for tank tightness testing and the county enter into a contract with the FBO for repayment of these funds. These tanks have to be tested before December 31, 1990.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the county attorney state in court the county position that the court determine what is in the best interest of all citizens regarding the abandonment of a portion of county roadway number TU 14 near Rayford Lee's property in exchange for another access roadway. The county will provide gravel for the new section of roadway.

Mr. Brandt, County Attorney, informed Council he had no knowledge of Petroleum Funds, Inc. and he advised the county to look into the possibility of recovering crude oil funds, but to proceed cautiously.
