MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, February 4, 1992 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

Mr. Stone made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Burrell, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the January 21, 1992 regular Council Meeting be adopted as printed.

At the request of Sheriff Earl Holcome, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfer for the Sheriff's Department be adopted.

Upon recommendation of the Aeronautics Commission, Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that the bid for T hangers at the airport be awarded to Pridemore Construction Co. This will be a lease-purchase with a total cost of \$233,000 with a twenty (20) year payback at 7.15% interest rate with quarterly payments of \$5,405.60. (See attached bid)
