**MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING**

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, October 20, 1992 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members except Mr. Harper present. Mr. Brandt, Acting County Attorney was present.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

Call to Order

The invocation was given by Mr. Stone.

Mr. Donald made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Burrell, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Harper absent) that the minutes of the October 6, 1992 meeting be adopted as printed.

Minutes

At the request of Mr. Dewitt Mize, Rural Fire Marshal and Mr. Joe Devita, Chief of Mountain Rest Fire Department, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Harper absent) that the county enter into an agreement with seventeen (17) property owners to install seventeen dry hydrants for the Rural Fire Department. This agreement will have to be approved by the County Attorney.

Also at the request of Mr. Mize and Mr. Devita, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Harper absent) that \$2,900 be taken from contingency and placed in line item number 10 005 00150 00032 for recommended ISO signs and posts for the dry hydrants.

Mr. Donald made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Harper absent) that the bid for rural fire equipment be awarded to the low bidder as delineated on the attached bid sheet.

Mr. Stone made a motion, seconded by Mr. Donald, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Harper absent) that the bid for posts, signs, blanks, sheeting and letters for 911 and the road department be awarded to the low bidder as delineated on the attached bid sheet.

Mr. Donald made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Harper absent) that the attached subrecipient agreement between the SC Appalachian Council of Governments and Oconee County in the amount of \$50,000 for GIS mapping, infrastructure mapping, etc. be adopted.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Harper absent) that Ordinance 92-4, "An Ordinance to Amend Section G, Subsection 5(1) of Ordinance 80-2, Oconee County Personnel Policies & Procedures" be adopted on third and final reading.

The Roads & Transportation Committee scheduled a meeting Thursday, October 22, 1992 to go out and look at the problem and discuss the action that needed to be taken regarding the problem.

To Mr. Donald's inquiry, Mr. Brandt, Acting Attorney, informed Council that Ordinance 92-3, "An Ordinance to Define & Regulate the use of all Oconee County Public Parks Designated for the Benefit of the Citizens of Oconee County" was not ready for second reading at this time, and Mr. Cain was going to prepare another draft of the ordinance to include language that the Corps of Engineers desires to have in the ordinance.

Mr. Stone made a motion, seconded by Mr. Donald, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Harper absent) that the regularly scheduled Council meeting dated November 3, 1992 be cancelled and a special meeting be called if there was any business that had to be taken care of before the regularly scheduled meeting of November 17, 1992.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Donald, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Harper absent) that the attached Memorandum of Agreement between Edward Henry Booker, MD and Oconee County for Dr. Booker to accept, store and administer the Engerix B Hepatitis vaccine to county employees, inmates and volunteers at \$5.00 per shot be entered into.

Mr. Stone made a motion, seconded by Mr. Donald, approved 5 - 0 that the purchase of a drive gear for the crane at the Rock Crusher be ratified. The cost of the drive gear was \$7,500 and Van Lott was a sole source for this equipment.

Mr. Donald made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Burrell, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Harper absent) that the motion be amended to take \$1,100 from contingency in order to bring someone in a week before the Account Technician goes on sick leave.

Mr. Brandt informed Council that a copy of the letter sent to Mr. Dyar, Veterans Affairs Officer requesting forms used in that office had been sent to the Delegation.

Mr. Stone made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Burrell, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Harper absent) that Ms. Cindy Reidhead & Mr. Ernst Hesterberg be appointed to the Advisory Committee for the Allocation of Tax Revenues.
