MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, December 15, 1992 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members present. Mr. Cain, County Attorney was also present.

Mr. Stone made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Burrell, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the regular Council Meeting held December 1, 1992 be adopted as printed.

Mr. Cain, County Attorney, advised Council against permitting this request due to the fact that although he would be a volunteer, he would be considered as an agent for the county and the county could be held liable for his actions, he was unsure of what liability the county could face as a result of granting this request and also he would not be covered by worker's compensation.

Mr. Donald made a motion that Mrs. Towe's request be granted, however, it died for lack of a second.

At the request of Mr. Howard Adams, Sewer Commission Chairman, Mr. Robert Winchester, Sewer Commission Director and Mr. Lamar Bailes of the Sewer Commission, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that Jordan, Jones and Goulding be awarded the bid for engineering services for the upgrade of the sewer plant at a cost of \$909,999.


When open session resumed there was no action taken regarding the personnel matter discussed.
