**MINUTES, SPECIAL MEETING, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL**

There was a special meeting of the Oconee County Council held December 22, 1992 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

Members of the press notified: Westminster News, Keowee Courier, Journal Tribune, Anderson Independent, Greenville News, WGOG Radio, WSNW Radio, WCCP Radio, WZLI/WLET Radio, WYFF TV & WLOS TV.

Press

Members of the press present: Ron Barnett - Greenville News.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

Call to Order

The invocation was given by Mr. Donald.

Invocation

At the request of Mr. Jack Hirst, CCS Director, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that the compactor at the Seneca Landfill be repaired pursuant to Section II,C,4 of Ordinance 85-2, "Oconee County Manual of Centralized Purchasing" at an approximate cost of \$16,952.

CCS

Mr. Stone made a motion, seconded by Mr. Donald, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfer for the CCS Department be adopted.

(Transfer)

At the recommendation of Mr. Jack Hirst, CCS Director and Ms. Marianne Dillard, Purchasing Director, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5 - 0 that the CCS Department lease a Rex compactor for one (1) month with an option to purchase pursuant to Section II,C,4 of Ordinance 85-2, "Oconee County Manual of Centralized Purchasing". The rental will go toward the purchase of the compactor, however, this compactor will not be purchased if a better compactor can be located.

CCS

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that the Rock Crusher be allowed to purchase a portable crushing plant at a cost of \$1,500. (See attached request)

Ms. Dillard, Purchasing Director, informed Council there was some soil at the road camp that needed to be tested further. Previous tests had shown some BEHP in the soil and there needed to be two (2) more test done on the holes where the soil had been removed from.

Soil

There is also going to be the cost of removing the soil at a possible cost of from \$50 per ton to \$250 per ton depending on what the tests show. The soil needs to be removed within ninety days of November 10, 1992. Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5 - 0 that Ms. Dillard take the necessary steps to get this soil removed in a timely manner keeping Mr. Crain informed of what is being done.

At the request of Sgt. Steve Pruitt of the Sheriff's Department, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that the attached "Increased Law Enforcement Services" agreement for patrol services in the recreation areas of the county be adopted.

Sheriff

At the request of Deputy Mike Crenshaw of the Sheriff's Department, Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that the county apply for a DARE Grant in the amount of \$26,868 with a county matching portion of \$8,960 for the implementation of a DARE program in the elementary schools in the county.

Mr. Donald made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5 - 0 that the attached change order for the airport be approved.

Airport

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 5 - 0 that Council go into executive session to discuss a legal matter.

Executive Session

When open session resumed, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Burrell, approved 5 - 0 that the County Attorney be given the authority to exercise best judgement to settle the law suits regarding the design and installation of the heating/air conditioning system at Lakeview Rest Home.
