ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 44 OF TITLE 12, SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS, 1976, AS AMENDED, THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A FEE AGREEMENT BETWEEN OCONEE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA AND WESTPOINT STEVENS, INC., AND MATTERS RELATING THERETO.

WHEREAS, Oconee County (the "County"), a public body corporate and politic organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina has, by a Resolution adopted on August 5, 1997 (the "Inducement Agreement"), authorized and entered into an Inducement Contract dated _____, 1997 with WestPoint Stevens, Inc., a corporation authorized to transact business in the State of South Carolina (the "Company") which provides for a payment in lieu of taxes for a project qualifying under the provisions of Title 4, Chapter 29 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976, as amended (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Fee in Lieu of Tax Simplification Act of 1997 (the "Simplification Act") was enacted effective June 24, 1997 and has substantially simplified the method and procedure for obtaining fee in lieu of tax benefits for expanding industry; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3 of the Simplification Act, an entity which will acquire property pursuant to an inducement resolution enacted in accordance with the provisions of Article 1, Chapter 12, Title 4 of the 1976 Code or Section 4-29-67 of the 1976 Code may with the consent of the county elect to have such property considered as economic development property as defined in Section 12-44-30(7); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Inducement Resolution and Section 4.10 of the Inducement Contract, the County and Company agreed to convert the transaction described therein to a transaction of the nature described in the Simplification Act upon the adoption of that legislation; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Company desire to enter into a Fee Agreement as defined in the Simplification Act concerning expansions or improvements of the Company's existing manufacturing facilities (the "Plants") which are located in the County and which will consist of the acquisition, construction, installation, design and engineering, in phases, of additional or improved machinery and equipment, building, improvements or fixtures which will constitute expansions or improvements of or in the Plants (the "Project").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL, the governing body of Oconee County (the "Council"), in meeting duly assembled:

Section 1. Pursuant to the Simplification Act and particularly Section 12-44-40(H) and (I) thereof, the County Council has made and hereby makes the following findings:

(a) By providing improved or expanded manufacturing, production and distribution capabilities which will enhance the productivity and general economic viability of the Plants, the Project will subserve the purposes of the Simplification Act by promoting industrial development in the County and in the State of South Carolina and are proper governmental and public purposes.

(b) The Project constitutes a "project" within the meaning of the Simplification Act.

(c) It is anticipated that the cost of planning, designing, acquiring, constructing and completing the Project will require expenditures of at least \$45,000,000.00

(d) Inasmuch as the Project, upon completion, will ensure continual employment at the Plants and will enhance the productivity and general economic viability of the Company, the Project is anticipated to benefit the general public welfare of the County by providing employment and other public benefits.

(e) Having evaluated the purposes to be accomplished by the Project as proper governmental and public purposes, the anticipated dollar amount and nature of the investment to be made, and the anticipated costs and benefits to the County, the County has determined that the Project is properly classified as economic development property.

(f) The Project will not give rise to a pecuniary liability of the County or to any charge against its general credit or taxing power.

Section 2. The Project is properly classified as economic development property under the Simplification Act.

Section 3. The form of the Fee Agreement concerning the Project in substantially the form as submitted herewith is approved.

Section 4. The Supervisor/Chairman of the County Council (the "Chairman") is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Fee Agreement, in substantially the form as submitted herewith, with any changes, insertions, and omissions as may be approved by the Chairman, with the advice of counsel, his execution being conclusive evidence of his approval.

Section 5. The consummation of all transactions contemplated by the Fee Agreement is hereby approved.

Section 6. The Chairman and all other appropriate officials of the County are hereby authorized to execute, deliver and receive any other agreements and documents as may be required in order to carry out, give effect to, and consummate the transactions contemplated by the Fee Agreement.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws

of the State of South Carolina.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon third reading by the Council.

Section 9. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any section, phrase, or provisions shall for any reason be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, that declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the sections, phrases, and provisions hereunder.

Section 10. All orders, resolutions, and parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of the conflict, hereby repealed.

We presently have no consolidated dispatch console. The county has an enhanced 911 system installed and all calls are received at the Law Enforcement Center in Walhalla. If an ambulance is needed, the call must be transferred from Walhalla to our hospital's EMS service located in Seneca. This new system will enable us to tie into the 911 system and make use of the appropriate screens. It will eliminate three separate phone systems. Because we are a hospital based EMS service, the system will handle only medical traffic.

**A RESOLUTION OF OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL
IN SUPPORT OF PRIVATE PROPERTY RIGHTS**

- Whereas,** Oconee County Council is duly elected by the citizens of Oconee County to uphold the public health, safety, general welfare, values, and beliefs of the citizens of Oconee County in the establishment of public policy, and
- Whereas,** the citizens of Oconee County value the freedoms and rights upon which the United States of America, the State of South Carolina, and the County of Oconee were founded, including the right to private property ownership, and
- Whereas,** Oconee County Council respects the ability of all citizens to exercise their rights of private property ownership, and respects the right of all citizens to utilize their private property in whatever manner they choose, so long as such usage does not impose a threat to the public health, safety, or general welfare, and
- Whereas,** Oconee County Council has no desire or intent to regulate the use of private property in any manner except to protect against direct threats to the public health, safety, or general welfare, and
- Whereas,** Oconee County Council is philosophically opposed to the concept of comprehensive zoning, in which each parcel of land is assigned a use category and permitted uses are restricted to those listed in the category.

Now Therefore, Be It Resolved that any regulations adopted by Oconee County Council will provide restrictions only to the extent necessary to protect the community from a direct threat to the public, health, safety, or general welfare. Also, no land use regulation will be adopted, unless preceded by adequate public notification and input.

Be It Further Resolved that the County Council of Oconee County will not consider the adoption of a comprehensive zoning ordinance, in which each parcel of land is assigned a use category and permitted uses are restricted to those listed in the category.

Pages 50-51 - Deleting the phrase Short-Term and Long Term Goals and changing it to read Goals. Bill Nelson made the motion to leave the wording as is. Dean Boggs seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Page 51 - Combing the first sentence "Oconee County will continue to support economic and industrial development." and "Oconee County will seek high quality, environmentally sound growth for new and existing business and industry, both domestic and international." Page 51 - County Council made the recommendation for the following statements be deleted "While the most immediate need is for the enactment of land use restrictions in the airport service area, the governing body of Oconee County shall have the option to enact such other regulations consistent with applicable law as are necessary and appropriate for the protection of health, safety and welfare in other areas of Oconee County. Bill Nelson made the motion to leave the statement in as written. Ernest Riley seconded the motion. Motion carried.

August 14, 1997

After a discussion between the County Council Committe and Planning Commission, Tommy Abbott made the recommendation to adopt a the option presented by Steve Pellisier, ACOG, to ammend the Land Use Plan to establish a basis for regulatory adult entertainment, gun clubs, and similar activities. Also a brief Community Facilities Element will be added to the Land Use Plan, which will be addressed more thourghly at a later date. Harry Hamilton ask for a vote from the Council Committe to adopt the Planning Commission's recommendation. Vote was unanimous.
