MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, October 21, 1997 at 3:00 pm in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the present County Attorney present.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor -Chairman Orr who welcomed the guests and media.

Mr. Timms made a motion, seconded by Ms. Burrell, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Hamilton abstaining) that the minutes of the October 7, 1997 meeting be adopted as printed.

Mr. Kenneth F. Williams, County Auditor, addressed Council regarding granting the five year exemption to manufacturing companies that have been sold.

Five Year Exemption

There are three companies in the county affected at this time: Beacon, Precision Tool & US Engine Valve. This would result in approximately \$30,000 - \$40,000 loss in tax dollars to the county.

After discussion, Council determined it would be in the best interest of the County to meet again regarding this matter before voting.

Upon request of Mr. Steven Brewer, Chair, Oconee Arts Commission, Mr. Hamilton made a motion, seconded by Mr. Timms, approved 5 - 0 that \$3,000 be taken from line item 010 006 00150 62110 and be paid to Blue Ridge Arts to supplement performing groups in the schools.

ORDINANCE 97-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 83-6, TO CHANGE THE NAME TO ANDERSON-OCONEE ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE COMMISSION D/B/A ANDERSON-OCONEE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 83-6, the Oconee County Council did establish the Anderson-Oconee Alcohol & Drug Abuse Commission and set forth the policy for the delivery of alcohol and drug abuse treatment and prevention services; and

WHEREAS, upon the advice and recommendation of the Anderson-Oconee Alcohol & Drug Abuse, the Oconee County Council has determined that it is necessary and appropriate to change the name of such commission to the Anderson-Oconee Alcohol and Drug Abuse Commission d/b/a Anderson-Oconee Behavioral Health Services;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF OCONEE COUNTY, IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED AND WITH A QUORUM PRESENT AND VOTING:

SECTION 1. NAME, PURPOSE

This Ordinance shall be known, and may be cited, in addition to the number, as "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 83-6, TO CHANGE THE NAME TO ANDERSON-OCONEE ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE COMMISSION D/B/A/ ANDERSON-OCONEE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES".

SECTION 11. PURPOSE AND EFFECT

- A. From the effective date hereof, Oconee County Ordinance 83-6 is hereby amended such that the name of the Anderson-Oconee Alcohol & Drug Abuse Commission shall be changed to and henceforth known and designated as the Anderson-Oconee Alcohol and Drug Abuse Commission d/b/a/ Anderson-Oconee Behavioral Health Services.
- B. All remaining terms and provisions of Oconee County Ordinance 83-6 not inconsistent herewith shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY

If any word(s), section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate district and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.




