#### MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, November 4, 1997 at 7:00 pm in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the present County Attorney present.

Members of the press present: Dick Mangrum - WGOG Radio, Naomi Snyder - Anderson Independent, Greg Oliver - Journal/Tribune & Ashton Hester - Keowee Courier.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor -Chairman Orr who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Thomas.

First on the agenda was a public hearing to receive written and/or oral comments regarding the purchase from Oconee County School District the Pine Street Elementary School property located in Walhalla, SC.

Mr. B. J. Littleton stated he thought it should be given to the county as the tax payers had already paid for it one time, he further stated he felt the cost of the asbestos removal should be taken off the cost of the purchase.

Mr. Jon Caime, County Engineer, stated the county would be acquiring a 37,000 square foot building at a cost of \$15 - \$25 per square foot which would result in a savings of \$1,500,000 - \$2,000,000 over trying to construct a new building.

The next item of business was a public hearing regarding the conveyance by Oconee Memorial Hospital, Inc. of a tract of land containing approximately 57 acres adjacent to the Seneca Landfill to Oconee County and the extension of the lease between Oconee County, as Lessor and Oconee Memorial Hospital, Inc. as Lessee of the property upon which Oconee Memorial Hospital is located to June 1, 2050.

Mr. B. J. Little was assured that the either party could be released from the lease upon one year's notice to the other party.

Dear Dr. Campbell:

At the regular meeting held October 21, 1997, the Board of Trustees of the School District of Oconee County voted to lease property to the Oconee County Health Department under the following conditions:

- A. That the lease be for a period of 99 years at \$1 per year; and
- B. That the property be used for the express purpose of constructing a new building to house the seneca Health Department; and
- C. That in the event the building ceases to be used as a health department or to house another county agency that said property revert to the school district; and
- D. That the health department pay all costs associated with the title checks, surveys and lease preparation.

The property to be leased is outlined on the attached page prepared by Louis P. Batson, III Architects. The lease will be for the site only. The school district will maintain ownership of the rear parking lot but keep it in good repair for use by the health department.





On behalf of the PRT Commission, I respectfully present the following request. Per County Ordinance 92-3, which gives the PRT Commission the ability to close the County Parks for a period and to exceed 90 days, the Commission requests to close the parks as usual for the entire 90 days, with the exception of day use at high Falls and South Cove Parks. At those two parks the boat ramps, tenns courts, in Italia field, and picnic areas would be available for use throughout the winter. Chair Ram Park, as well as all other comprisoned and renial facilities would close for the period.

The Commission members feel that the above would accommodate the highest percentage of anticipated use while still allowing for the response resource and facility recovery period. Based on previous use and revenue figures the total amount of anticipated revenue for the period would only be \$750.00, which would easily be offset by the increased ease of maintenance and the ability to adequately plan for the season.

Dear Mr Orr and Council Members:

The PRT Commission would like to present the following information concerning the "parking fee program" as supplemented at High Falls and South Cove County Parks earlier this year. Total amounts collected for the period are \$27,566.90, which was taken in on Friday. Saturday, and Sunday only, between memorial Weekend and Labor Day Weekend. This is broken down further in the attached thart.

As projected, the implementation of this fee has done several positive things. It has provided a totally new revenue source which primarily targets the day use areas. The fee has reduced the amount of "non-taser" traffic through the parks (i.e. "cruising"). It has reduced the numbers of cars being driven to evenus and projected "carpooling.". This in turn has fixed up parking areas which scere congested poer the weakend periods and made the entire parks safer for padestrian or hicycle traffic. The fee has also promuted the use of "off-season" rental periods which narmally would have remained open productor no tevenue.

Overall, complaints have not been that bad. One thing keeps coming up as a securring theme, however. Most visitors who voice an opinion say that they don't on wouldn't mind paying the fee if it cause directly back into the parks for something they could see or use.

Our question for Council is this: Would it be possible for this revenue to be placed in a separate capital expenditure line item in addition to the regular budget appropriation from Council? This money would then be earmarked for projects directly benefiting those parks where collected, much like the system currently used by Georgia State Parks. The Park Stall could then plan for certain additional projects each year and it would satisfy the public's major complaint against the fee.

The Commission would also like to propose the following concerning camping fees for the 1998 season. Instead of going to a flat fee of \$15.00 we recommend a

staggered rate of \$13.00 for in-county campers and \$15.00 for out of county. Again, we feel that this would address some of the chief complaints and still allow for "fair market" pricing.
