MINUTES, SPECIAL MEETING, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Oconee County Council held a special meeting Tuesday, June 9, 1998 at 6:00 pm in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

The invocation was given by Mr. Hamilton.

Invocation

At the regular Council meeting June 2, 1998 Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mr. Timms, approved 4 - 0 that third and final reading of Ordinance 98-6, "1998-99 OCONEE COUNTY BUDGET ORDINANCE" be tabled until this special meeting.

Ord. 98-6

Mr. Timms made a motion, seconded by Mr. Thomas, approved 4 - 0 that the motion that third and final reading of ordinance 98-6 be taken from the table.

Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 3 - 0 (Mr. Hamilton abstaining) that the motion be amended to include the attached list of changes since the second reading of the budget ordinance.

Mr. Timms made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton that the budget be amended to include an additional \$1,500,000 for the school budget. After discussion, this motion was withdrawn.

Mr. Timms then made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 3 - 1 (Mr. Thomas voting against) that \$558,000 be taken from county operations, specifically road paving, and the millage be increased sufficiently to generate \$942,000 to give the school budget an additional \$1,500,000. This gives the school district a total of \$2,934,500 in new funding for fiscal year 1998-99.

The motion, as amended was then adopted

Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mr. Timms, approved 3 - 1 (Mrs. Hughes voting against) that the cost of 4' X 8' rip rap be \$7.00 per ton until January 1, 1999 and at that time the cost be \$9.00 per ton.

Mr. Hamilton made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 4 - 0 that the attached Drug Control and System Improvement Program Grant No. 1F98030 Oconee County Sheriff's Office School Resource Officer be adopted.
