MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, May 4, 1999 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

Press:

Members of the press notified (by mail): Journal/Tribune, Keowee Courier, Westminster News, Anderson Independent, Greenville News, WGOG Radio, WSNW Radio, WCCP Radio, WPEK Radio, The Times Upstate, Northland Cablevision, WYFF TV, WSPA TV & WLOS TV.

Members of the press present: Laura Gabrels – Anderson Independent, & Brian Fulkerson – Journal/Tribune.

Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Orr who welcomed the guests and media.

Invocation:

Mr. Hall gave the invocation.

Minutes:

Mrs. Hughes made a motion, seconded by Mr. Timms, approved 5 – 0 that the minutes of the regular meeting held April 20, 1999 meeting be adopted as printed.

Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 5 – 0 that the minutes of the special meeting held April 26, 1999 be adopted as printed.

Resolution 99-2:

Mr. Hamilton presented the attached resolution in honor of the late Marvin Singleton Cely to Mrs. Cely.

Public Hearing (DAVCO Building):

Next the Council conducted a public hearing to receive written and/or oral comments regarding the county leasing a county owned building to an individual located at 10522 Wells Highway, Seneca, known as the “DAVCO” Building.

Mr. B. J. Littleton inquired if the county would have the right to inspect for damage to the building while it is being leased.

Mr. Cain, County Attorney, assured Mr. Littleton the contract will have a provision that says the county can, at reasonable times come in and inspect the building.

The lease as proposed will be for \$2,500 per month and the lease will contain a ninety-day notice after a five-year period if either party should opt to discontinue the contract.

Mr. Cain also informed Council that when the lease was prepared in final form, it would be brought to them for approval.

Public Hearing (Old 911 Office Building):

The next item on the agenda was a public hearing to receive written and/or oral comments regarding the selling and removal of a wood frame building owned by the county, located at 203 Booker Drive, Walhalla, known as the old “911 Office Building”.

There were no written and/or oral comments presented for this public hearing.

Sheriff's Department:

Upon request of Sheriff Singleton, Mr. Hamilton made a motion, seconded by Mr. Timms, approved 5 – 0 that the Sheriff be permitted to transfer \$25,000 from salary line items into the Sheriff's Department overtime line item to complete this fiscal year.

Resolution 99-8:

Upon recommendation of the Roads & Transportation Committee, Council unanimously adopted Resolution 99-8, “A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE SCORING CRITERIA PERTAINING TO PAVING EXISTING COUNTY ROADWAYS” rescinding Resolution 79-5.

Criteria for Acceptance of Roadways:

Upon request of Mr. Thomas, consideration of approval of criteria for accepting roadways other than subdivision roadways as a recommendation to the Planning Commission to be made a part of the Developmental Standards Ordinance was withdrawn from the agenda.

Culvert for Road Department:

Upon recommendation of Mr. Hoyt Orr, Road Foreman & Ms. Marianne Dillard, Purchasing Agent, Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mr. Timms, approved 5 – 0 that the bid for culvert for the road department be awarded to White's Culvert Co. who was low bid at a cost of \$48,049 for the approximate number of culverts to be used. (See attached bid sheet)

Emergency Preparedness Radios:

Upon recommendation of Mr. Henry Gordon, Emergency Preparedness Director & Ms. Dillard, Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 5 – 0 that the bid for portable radios for EPA be awarded to First Communications who was low bid at \$12,257.70. (See attached bid sheet)

Old 911 Office Building:

Mr. Hall made a motion, seconded by Mr. Timms, approved 3 – 0 (Mrs. Hughes abstaining, Mr. Thomas excused himself from this item of business) that the bid for the old 911 Office Building be awarded to Kenneth F. & Kim T. Williams, Jr. who was the only bidder at \$1,055.25. (See attached bid sheet)

Listing of County Buildings/Properties:

Mr. Hall made a motion that Council be provided a list of county owned buildings/properties. However, Mr. Timms informed Council he had been given this listing from the Assessor's Office and he would be happy to give the other members a copy of it. Mr. Hall withdrew his motion.

Solid Waste:

Mr. Hall made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 5 – 0 that Council be provided with a copy of the previously conducted survey of the Construction & Demolition Performance as soon as possible.

Lease Agreements:

Mr. Hall made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 5 – 0 that Council be provided with a listing of all lease agreements including the details of each agreement that has an aggregate exceeding \$5,000 per year.

Roads & Transportation Committee Meeting:

Mr. Thomas requested that the Roads & Transportation Committee meet Tuesday, May 18, 1999 at 1:30 PM, however there is another meeting already scheduled for that date.

Solid Waste:

Mrs. Hughes made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hall, approved 5 – 0 that, in light of the fact that a new study is to be conducted regarding the hours of the C&D Landfill the county delay implementation of the new hours previously adopted.

Planning Retreat:

Mr. Timms made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton that the Supervisor schedule a time and place for a Strategic Planning Retreat.

Mr. Hall made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 5 – 0 that the motion be amended that this be a Strategic Planning Workshop and it be held before June 30, 1999.

The motion, as amended was adopted 5 – 0.

Courthouse Records:

Mr. Timms informed Council that he and Mr. Caime, County Engineer, would be meeting with the department heads in the courthouse Thursday, May 6, 1999 at 4:00 PM to discuss their records and storage needs.

Clemson Extension Agent Honor:

Mr. Timms informed Council that Mrs. Carolyn Harris, Oconee County Clemson Extension Agent was recently honored with an award, Oconee County placed number one in the State Farm City Program preschool and kindergarten children.

Chattooga River Resort:

Mr. Timms requested that Council tour the Chattooga River Resort, a time will have to be scheduled and also the tour will have to be advertised.

Parks, Recreation & Tourism Director Position:

Mr. Timms made a motion that the county recruit and fill the position of PRT Director. However, after discussion this motion was withdrawn and will be discussed again at the next Budget & Finance Committee meeting.

Resolution 99-9:

Mr. Timms made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hall, approved 5 – 0 that a Resolution be adopted honoring Mr. Herb Hosea who has been over the American Legion Baseball Program for over fifty (50) years.

Letter of Appreciation:

Mr. Hall made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 5 – 0 that a letter of appreciation be sent to Senator Thomas Alexander, Representative Bill Sandifer & Representative Lindsay Graham for their assistance in securing grants and monies for the Newry Sewer Project.

County Wide Recreation Department:

Mr. Hall made a motion, that an AD HOC Committee be appointed by Council to do a feasibility study of the possibility of a countywide recreation department. After a brief discussion, this motion was withdrawn.

Lila Doyle:

Mr. Hall asked that the county support the hospital with an addition to Lila Doyle for twenty-five medicaid beds. However, Mr. Orr stated such a request would have to be presented to Council by the Hospital.

Solicitor's Office:

Mrs. Lombard, Finance Director, informed Council she had received a letter from Solicitor Ducworth regarding the grant for the position that was created in the Solicitor's Office as the motion was made pending receipt of this letter.

Motor Pool (Contingency):

Upon request of Mr. Lee Davis, Motor Pool Foreman, & Mr. Hoyt Orr, Road Foreman, Mr. Thomas made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 5 – 0 that \$25,000 be taken from contingency and placed in line item 010 012 00200 02022 vehicle maintenance for the Supervisor's Office.

Resolution Urging Stronger Regulations Regarding Video Poker:

Mr. Hall made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 5 – 0 that Mr. Cain, County Attorney, draft a resolution urging stronger regulations regarding video poker.

Zoning Issues:

Mr. Hamilton made a motion, seconded by Mr. Thomas, approved 5 – 0 that any zoning issues be referred to the Planning Commission.

Executive Session:

By consensus Council went into executive session for the purpose of discussing legal and contractual matters.

RESOLUTION 99-8

Oconee County Council, in session duly assembled, hereby adopts and proclaims the following resolution as hereinafter set forth:

TITLE: "A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE SCORING CRITERIA PERTAINING TO PAVING EXISTING COUNTY ROADWAYS"

SECTION I: PURPOSE

The purpose of this Resolution is to amend the scoring criteria pertaining to paving of existing county roadways and rescind Resolution 75-9.

It is declared to be the policy of Oconee County regarding the paving or improvement of existing County roads:

- A) The Supervisor of Oconee County shall furnish to the County Council a list of roads, presently designated as "County Roads", which are unpaved and which should be improved according to the priority ranking.
- B) The Supervisor shall, wherever possible, notify property owners along such roads that the same shall be improved and paved according to its priority status when certain conditions are met, including the following:
 - ❖ That the right of way for such road is at least fifty (50) feet in width and includes a right of way for a one hundred (100) foot diameter cul-de-sac on dead end roadways.
 - ❖ There shall be no cost to the County in acquiring any additional right of way necessary to meet the minimum right of way requirement, and that such acquisition shall be done by the landowners
 - ❖ Any fencing required to be moved shall be the sole responsibility of the landowners
- C) That the Oconee County Council may, upon recommendation of the County Supervisor, find that the meeting of requirements for improving and paving of existing County roads cannot be obtained, and it is in the vital interests of the County and its citizens to waive any or all of the above requirements; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, such waivers shall be done on an individual basis by the Council.

D) The scoring formula shall be as follows:

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

COUNTY OF OCONEE

Oconee County Council, in session duly assembled, hereby adopts the following criteria and requests the Oconee County Planning Commission make it a part of the DEVELOPMENTAL STANDARDS ORDINANCE:

SECTION I: PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to set forth the criteria for the acceptance of roadways other than subdivision roads for county maintenance so as to specifically permit churches and business establishments to be considered in determining eligibility of roads for acceptance.

SECTION II: ELIGIBILITY

A roadway will be eligible for acceptance into the county road system for maintenance by Oconee County only after meeting the following requirements:

- 1) The roadway must border along property owned by at least three (3) separate property owners or serve at least three (3) property owners
- 2) The roadway must connect to at least one (1) federal, state, county or municipal roadway.
- 3) The roadway must serve at least three (3) qualifying units owned by separate individuals per .4 mile. A qualifying unit is :
 - a) a conventional type home used as a permanent home; or
 - b) two (2) mobile homes used as permanent residences owned by separate individuals; or
 - c) a church duly incorporated pursuant to the laws of the State of South Carolina and tax exempt pursuant to the Internal Revenue Code which has been using the particular location as its principal place of worship for a continuous period of twelve (12) months next preceding consideration; or
 - d) a business establishment existing and/or licensed to do business pursuant to the laws of the State of South Carolina which possesses a valid South Carolina Sales Tax or Federal Identification Number and has been doing business at the particular location for a continuous period of twelve (12) months next preceding consideration;

However, maintenance may not extend beyond next to the last house unless the roadway is serving more than one (1) property owner. Further, it will be the responsibility of the property owner to provide right of way for sufficient turn around at end of county maintained portion of roadway.

SECTION V: OBSTRUCTIONS OF COUNTY MAINTAINED ROADWAYS

No county maintained roadway may be barricaded in any way and may not be posted with any type sign such as "Private", "Posted", "Keep Out", or any other similar sign. But the roadway shall remain open at all times for use by the public at large as to local, state & federal laws.

SECTION VI: CONDITIONAL ACCEPTANCE

All roadways accepted by Oconee County for maintenance under the terms and conditions of this Ordinance will be conditionally accepted for a three (3) year period. If at any time during this probationary period any of the above criteria required as a condition for acceptance ceases to exist, the roadway may be abandoned by resolution of County Council in which case the roadway shall revert back to the original owner(s) and Oconee County shall no longer be responsible for the maintenance thereof.

SECTION VII: SURFACE TREATMENT OF COUNTY ROADWAYS

Further, Oconee County presently has approximately two hundred, fifty (250) miles of dirt county maintained roadway. Therefore, any and all roadways accepted under this Ordinance shall not be considered for surface treatment at county expense during the probationary period after which time the roadway shall be given the same consideration as all other county maintained roadways.

SECTION VIII: EXTENSION OF EXISTING COUNTY ROADWAYS

An extension to an existing county maintained roadway may be accepted into the county system for maintenance when the extension serves at least one (1) qualifying unit per .2 mile, scores at least 22.5 per qualifying unit using the above referenced formula, and meets or exceeds requirements of this and/or other applicable ordinances.

SECTION IX: REPEALER

Oconee County Ordinance 91-9 is hereby repealed.




