Local Workforce Investment Area Subsequent Designation

Pursuant to Section 116 of the Workforce Investment Act, local Workforce Investment Areas (LWIA's) were granted temporary designation for a period of two years ending June 30, 2002. With June 30th fast approaching, a formal petition for local Workforce Investment Area Subsequent Designation has been developed for completion in order to fulfill the requirement for Formal Area Designation as prescribed in the Act.

Subsequent Designation is based on two factors. The first factor is a local area's ability to substantially meet performance measures as defined by the State Workforce Investment Board. The second factor is based on fiscal integrity as defined in Section 116 (4)(3)(B) of the Act.

Because the performance data for the initial designation period ending June 30, 2002, will not be available until October, 2002, the State is focusing on fiscal integrity and systems improvement. Local areas have made great strides in coordinating area designation, board configuration, partner involvement, one-stop systems and other workforce development processes. Although performance measures play a vital role in ensuring qualitative and quantitative analysis of programs and services, they do not provide a complete picture of the processes developed and goals achieved by the local areas in Program Year 2000.

All twelve of South Carolina's Workforce Investment Area's have successfully implemented WIA and are looking ahead to improving the services and programs being offered in their areas. The enclosed Formal Petition for Subsequent Designation will be based on fiscal integrity and will designate local areas through June 30, 2003.

Local Workforce Investment Area Subsequent Designation Procedures
July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2005

Background

Entities requesting area designation originally applied under one of two criteria. The first criteria was the grandfathering in of existing Service Delivery Areas based on size, fiscal integrity and past performance. The second criteria was based on a new application that addressed geographic areas served by local, intermediate, post-secondary, and vocational educational institutions; the extent to which local areas were consistent with labor market areas; the distance individuals would need to travel to receive services; and the resources of such local areas that were available to effectively administer Title I activities.

All of South Carolina's Local Workforce Investment Areas were temporarily designated under one of the two criteria listed above.

Submission of the Formal Subsequent Designation Petition

The formal Workforce Investment Area Designation Petition included in this package must be used to request Subsequent Designation. The South Carolina Employment Security Commission (SCESC), as the administrative agency for the WIA in the State, will accept petitions until the close of business, Friday, March 29, 2002. Those areas requesting changes in their configuration will need to solicit public comment as part of the attached Petition.

State Workforce Investment Board Recommendations to the Governor

Once all petitions have been submitted, the SWIB will make its recommendations to the Governor for final designation.

Notification of Workforce Investment Area Subsequent Designation

Areas will be notified of their formal designation status within fifteen (15) days of the Governor's decision.

Appeals

- A. A petitioning entity denied designation under Section 116 (n)(3) may submit a written appeal to the SWIB within twenty (20) days of receiving written denial notification. Appeals submitted after this time will not be considered.

- B. The appealing entity must explain why it believes the denial is contrary to the provisions of Section 115(a)(3) of the WIA. No other cause for appeal will be considered under this Section.
- C. The SWIB must consider and respond in writing to such an appeal within twenty (20) days of its receipt.
- D. If the petitioning entity is again denied such designation, further appeal to the Secretary of Labor may occur if the entity alleges 1) that the decision of the Governor violates Section 116(a)(3) or 2) that the entity was not accorded procedural rights under the State appeal process described herein.
- E. All such appeals to the Secretary must be submitted within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the notification of denial by the SWIB. Such appeals shall be submitted by certified mail, return receipt requested to the Secretary, US Department of Labor, Washington D.C. 20210, Attention: ASET. The appealing entity must simultaneously notify the Governor and the SWIB of such an appeal to the Secretary.
- F. The Secretary shall accept the appeal and make a decision only with regard to determining whether or not 1) the denial is consistent with Section 116(a)(3) of the WIA and/or 2) the appealing party was accorded procedural rights under the State's appeal process. The Secretary may consider any comments by the Governor.
- G. The Secretary shall make a final decision within thirty (30) days after the appeal is received. The Secretary shall notify the Governor and the appellant in writing of the Secretary's decision.



Public Education Committee

On Tuesday, March 19 Oconee County Council, in a 5-0 vote, authorized Marion Lyles, council member for district 4 and facilitator for the government services task force, to form a Public Education Committee to "fairly and accurately describe the advantages and disadvantages of both the existing council-supervisor and proposed council-administrator forms of government, to ensure an informed vote in the November, 2003 referendum".

The objective was to find well known, well respected community leaders, willing to serve, able to recruit other capable people as needed, and willing to accept the stipulation that fair and accurate information on both forms of government is a requirement in the public education. Membership was set at five as an optimum number to ensure the committee wouldn't be so large that it would have trouble getting anything done, or so small that it would have too few ideas or too much workload. The five community leaders who have agreed to serve on the Public Education Committee are:

- 1. Gary Duncan - CPA:** Gary is founder and owner of the Gary T. Duncan, CPA Firm, PA, a professional accounting firm in Seneca. His extensive professional contacts throughout the county in business, service organizations and the general public will be an asset to the committee.
- 2. Jerry Edwards – President, Edwards Publications:** Jerry has BA degrees in accounting and business. His knowledge of the community and its leaders gained as publisher of the Daily Journal and his interest in accurate reporting of community affairs will be valuable to the committee.
- 3. John Hostetler – Retired Principal, Walhalla H.S.:** John has B.S., M. Ed and Ed. S. degrees from Clemson. He has participated in numerous professional organizations and projects, and has received many professional honors and awards. His experience in the field of education and his contacts in the community will be valuable to the committee.
- 4. Barbara Sokel – Retired Computer Professional:** Barbara has a BS degree in business. She has been active in her church, newcomers, the local Republican Party, and is a board member of the League of Women Voters which will be invited to sponsor forums or debates on the referendum.
- 5. Neal Workman – President & CEO, Trebel Corp.:** Neal has a B.A. from the Wofford School of Economics, and has served with distinction on numerous public service, charitable, business, and local government boards or committees in Oconee, Pickens and Anderson counties.

To be most effective, the committee will be asked to set its own course, taking any direction from county council through Marion Lyles. It will also have two non-voting advisory members who will be asked to attend all committee meetings. Joe Newton from ACOG, will provide research, review all committee output and if appropriate, submit its materials to the state ethics commission for approval. Task force chairman, Bob Manka, will be responsible for representing the task force members, their findings and their recommendations for this referendum.

If additional volunteer personnel are needed to achieve the committee's objectives, it will be up to the committee itself to recruit and utilize them. If other citizens want to volunteer their services, the committee itself will determine how to best utilize them. If any county funding is needed for committee use, its requests will be submitted through Marion Lyles for approval by county council.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

SOUTH CAROLINA BUDGET AND CONTROL BOARD
OFFICE OF RESEARCH AND STATISTICAL SERVICES
THE SOUTH CAROLINA GEODETIC SURVEY SECTION

AND

THE COUNTY OF OCONEE, SOUTH CAROLINA

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is between the South Carolina Budget and Control Board, Office of Research and Statistical Services' The Geodetic Survey Section, hereafter referred to as SCGS; and OCONEE County, South Carolina, hereinafter referred to as the County.

SCGS is responsible for providing assistance to qualified counties toward the modernization of Land Information Systems (LIS) utilizing geodetic control as the framework for creation of an accurate, coordinate based mapping system. The County has the responsibility of conforming to the National Standards of Map Accuracy, FGCC Standards and Specifications for Geodetic Control Development, and the South Carolina program for statewide mapping standardization.

II. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Agreement is to obtain accurate, coordinate based mapping of the County in accordance with State and Federal mapping specifications, to provide the basis for multi-user computerized mapping systems and to facilitate the utilization, maintenance and exchange of spatial-reference information among the user groups.

III. RESPONSIBILITIES

A. SCGS SHALL:

1. Provide funding assistance as available to the County to support LIS programs contingent upon the County showing proof of financial expenditures of at least 50% of the funding for their respective projects
2. Assist the National Geodetic Survey by establishing an appropriately dense and distributed set of primary geodetic control points using Global Positioning System (GPS) techniques to support Land Information System (LIS), as required for orthophoto base mapping.
3. Provide to the County technical assistance and information concerning procedures, and related data gained from similar mapping projects, for consideration and potential application to the State program
4. Review, approve and monitor all work plans, contracts, statements of work, procedures and specifications developed by the County for use in the mapping project to ensure compliance with contractual obligations
5. Assist the county with preparation of technical specifications to be sent to prospective mapping contractors in the form of a Request For Proposal (RFP)
6. Review contractor proposals and assist in contractor selection in conjunction with county procurement requirements
7. Review and verify all deliverables received from contractors or consultants of final map products prior to delivery to the County.

B. THE COUNTY SHALL:

1. The County shall ensure accurate base mapping in accordance with state specifications as defined in Standards and Procedures for County Base Mapping Programs and the Federal Geodetic Control Specifications and Standards to ensure quality mapping.
2. The county must have a financial commitment of at least an amount equal to or greater than the amount of funding provided by SCGS (Federal and/or State) prior to receiving any funding assistance.
3. Develop contracts, specifications, technical standards and procedures for each county where Federal and/or State monetary assistance is to be provided for LIS. These documents will be submitted to SCGS as they are developed. Work shall not proceed with any phase until SCGS has reviewed the appropriate documents for compliance with accepted geodetic, photogrammetric or computerized mapping practices and procedures.
4. Oversee the procurement of mapping services and to maintain all records related to billings, payments and accounts with regard to the mapping project in accordance with county procurement requirements.

5. The County further agrees to expend the County 50% allocation, federal and/or SCGS funds toward the mapping project during the designated award period and is prohibited from expending Federal and/or State grant funds, or in-kind goods or services, for purposes of providing transportation, travel, and any other expenses for any County employee.
6. The county must adhere to the requirements of retention and access to financial supporting documents, and all other records associated with an award-supported project.
 - (a) In general, records must be retained for three years from the date the recipient submits its last expenditure report for the award period.
 - (b) If any litigation, claim, negotiation, audit or other action involving the records has been started before the expiration of the three-year retention period, the records must be retained until completion of the action and resolution of all issues which arise from it, or until the end of regular three-year period, whichever is later.
7. The County must not make award at any time to any party which is debarred or suspended or is otherwise excluded from or ineligible for participation in Federal assistance programs under Executive Order 12549, "Debarment and Suspension." Subscriptions to the Consolidated List of Debarred, Suspended, and Ineligible Contractors published by the U.S. General Services Administration, Office of Acquisition Policy, may be obtained from the Superintendent of Documents, U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C.
8. The County shall submit quarterly to SCGS copies of project related expenditures for review regarding the mapping project.
9. In accordance with Section 11 (above), the County shall, upon request from SCGS, provide copies of information generated through the LIS Modernization Program at cost of reproduction.
10. The South Carolina Geodetic Survey reserves the right to duplicate and distribute copies of the digital maps to other state agencies for their official use. The transfer of information will be predicated on the receiving state agency agreeing not to redistribute the data or hold the South Carolina Geodetic Survey or the County liable for content or accuracy.

II. AMENDMENT AND REVIEW:

This MOU may be amended at any time by mutual written consent by SCGS and the County.

IV. TERM OF THE MOU

This agreement will become effective upon award of Federal and/or State assistance and signature on this MOU by both the SCGS and the County and continue for a period of one year from date of the award. Both parties to this MOU have the option to continue this project, subject to the availability of appropriated funds and administrative approvals. This MOU is null and void in the event funding is unable to be obtained by either or both parties.

The Period covered under this MOU will be from November 1, 2001 through October 31, 2002.

V. FUNDING ARRANGEMENT

Federal funds in the amount of \$15,000.00 will be awarded to OCONEE County to perform its task; upon the County showing proof of financial expenditures of at least 50% of the funding for their respective project.

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-

**AN ORDINANCE REORGANIZING THE OCONEE COUNTY SOLID WASTE
COMMISSION, AND TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 79-19, DATED**

NOVEMBER 6, 1979

BY OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL, in Council duly assembled and with a quorum present and voting,

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1: Name, Purpose, Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be known, in addition to the number, as "An Ordinance Reorganizing the Oconee County Solid Waste Commission, and to Repeal Ordinance No. 79-19, Dated November 6, 1979", and shall be effective on the 1st day of May, 2002.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to reorganize the Oconee County Solid Waste Commission, with the duties and authority as herein provided.

Section 2: Membership

The membership of the Oconee County Solid Waste Commission shall be ten (10) in number, three (3) of whom shall be ex officio non voting members and shall be composed of the incumbent Mayors of the towns of Walhalla, Westminster and Seneca, or their designees, and such ex officio members of this Commission shall serve at the pleasure of the municipal government of the municipality which each represents. The remaining seven (7) members shall be selected and appointed by a majority vote of the membership of Oconee County Council voting in Council duly assembled, with one (1) member of Oconee County Council voting in Council duly assembled, with one (1) member being selected from each of the five Council Districts in existence and as delineated at the time of the adoption of this Ordinance and two (2) members appointed by the Oconee County Supervisor. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, if after an appointment of a member to represent a particular Council District of Oconee County to this Commission, such District is altered then such member shall continue to serve thereon for the remainder of the term to which he or she is appointed, irrespective of his/her place of residence.

Should any member of this Commission appointed by County Council move and establish residence outside the County or the District where such Member was residing at the time of the appointment to this Commission, such moving shall constitute a resignation by the Member and a replacement Member shall be appointed to fill the unexpired term of such resigned Member.

Section 3: Term of Members

Each member of this Commission appointed by County Council shall serve for a term of four (4) years.

If or in the event any member of the Commission appointed by County Council shall fail to attend fifty (50%) percent of the regularly scheduled meetings within a period of twelve (12) calendar months, he/she shall be deemed to have resigned his/her position and may be replaced without notice by action of Oconee County Council.

Section 4: Organization, Meetings, Officers

The Oconee County Solid Waste Commission shall meet at least once each quarter.

At the first meeting of each even-numbered year, there shall be elected a Chairman, a Vice Chairman and a Secretary, together with such other officers as the Commission may deem necessary, and these officers shall serve for a period of two (2) years or until their successors are duly elected and qualified. Vacancies in any such office by reason of death, resignation or replacement shall be filled for the unexpired term of the officer whose position becomes vacant.

In addition, the Commission may duly adopt such By-Laws as may be necessary for the orderly performance of its duties and functions. Any By-Laws which may be adopted by the Commission for the orderly performance of its duties shall comply with the provisions of the general law of the State of South Carolina and of this Ordinance, and all other Ordinances of Oconee County, including but not limited to the Freedom of Information Act.

Section 5: Powers and Duties

The Oconee County Solid Waste Commission is created to assist the Oconee County Solid Waste Department as necessary and advise County Council via the Solid Waste Director or the Chairman of the Commission in conjunction with the Solid Waste Director.

Section 6: Salaries and Funding

Each member of the Oconee County Solid Waste Commission shall be paid the sum of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars per year, plus expenses for out of county travel, as sole compensation. All ex-officio members (with the exception of those members who are appointed or elected to local governmental agencies and who by virtue of their position, can be reimbursed by the municipality for their expenses incurred attending board meetings) are to receive the same salary (\$100.00 per year) as voting members. Any expense item or claim for same shall be first approved by the Solid Waste Director. In no event shall any member of

the Commission be entitled to any other compensation, direct or indirect, for services on the Commission and such member shall not provide any services, materials, products, goods or equipment to the County unless the same is sold or offered for sale in accordance with existing County and State purchasing procedures.

In the event that any member of the Commission is a permanent employee of the County, he/she shall not be entitled to any additional compensation.

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR A REFERENDUM TO ALLOW THE
QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF OCONEE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA TO
VOTE TO RETAIN THE COUNCIL-SUPERVISOR FORM OF GOVERNMENT
OR CHANGE TO THE COUNCIL-ADMINISTRATOR FORM OF
GOVERNMENT**

Section I. Authority; Purpose. This Ordinance is authorized pursuant to Section 4-9-10 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976), as amended. The purpose of this Ordinance shall be to provide for a referendum to allow the qualified electors of Oconee County, South Carolina to vote to retain the Council-Supervisor form of government or change to the Council-Administrator form of government.

Section II. Effect. The Oconee County Voter Registration Election Commission shall take such steps as are necessary and appropriate to hold a referendum in conjunction with the general election to be held on November 5, 2002 to allow the qualified electors of Oconee County, South Carolina to vote and to retain the Council-Supervisor form of government or change to the Council-Administrator form of government as provided for in Section 4-9-610, et. seq., Code of Laws of South Carolina (1976) as amended.

The questions for such referendum shall be stated as follows:

Are you in favor of Oconee County retaining its present form of government (Council-Supervisor), or are you in favor of the County adopting the Council-Administrator form of government?

**IN FAVOR OF RETAINING THE PRESENT COUNCIL-SUPERVISOR FORM
OF GOVERNMENT.**

**IN FAVOR OF CHANGING TO COUNCIL-ADMINISTRATOR FORM OF
GOVERNMENT.**

Section III. Implementation. The Oconee County Voter Registration Elections Commissions shall verify the results of such referendum as provided by law.

Should the present form of government receive a majority favorable vote of those qualified electors voting, the present form shall continue without further action by the Oconee County Council. Should the Council-Administrator form of government receive a majority favorable vote of those qualified electors voting, then, in such event, the Oconee County Council shall enact an Ordinance establishing the new form of government in accordance with the provisions of applicable law.

Section IV. Savings Clause. If any word, sentence, paragraph, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid for any reason, the remaining words, sentences, paragraphs and provisions shall not be affected but shall remain in full force and effect.

Section V. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon third and final reading.


