ORDINANCE NO. 2003-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-14, AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ACCEPTANCE OF ROADWAYS IN SUBDIVISIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL, in session, duly assembled with a quorum present and voting:

The language in Section III (F) (9) stating the following:

Upon acceptance of a street or road, all materials and workmanship used grading and paving must carry a full one (1) year warranty from the contractor who constructed the road and/or the contractor responsible for paving and in addition a maintenance bond and the penal sum equal to the contract for the above mentioned work performed with Oconee County named as beneficiary.

Is hereby repealed. This language shall be replaced by the following language:

Upon the acceptance of a street or a road, all materials and workmanship for the sub-grade and paving of said street or road must carry a full (1) year warranty from the contractor who constructed the road and a maintenance bond from the owner and/or contractor in the sum equal to the cost of the sub-grading work and paving work for said street or road with Oconee County named as the beneficiary.

Policy Number 4-3 of the Oconee County Personnel Manual-Sick Leave- is hereby amended to include the following language:

Transfer of Sick Leave:

Employees are authorized to transfer accumulated sick time to another employee who has exhausted his or her sick time. The employee who transfers sick time to another employee shall lose the number of days accumulated sick time that is transferred. The transfer of sick time shall be done on a volunteer basis.

Oconee County Council,

Oconee County presents to us, the people, that it will comply with State and Federal laws and will take no action (that is illegal, immoral or unethical).

South Carolina law code Sec. 4-1-20 gives procedures to follow when citizens desire to relocate the courthouse that requires the favor at election of two-thirds of the qualified voters.

In spite of written and verbal protests of hundreds of citizens, County Council has deemed it appropriate to build another courthouse at 205 W. Main Street, Walhalla, South Carolina. Council has stated its intention to move court to the new building. After proceeding with construction of a new Courthouse building, the Council Buildings and Grounds Committee in October, 2002 inspected the existing Courthouse at 211 W. Main Street in Walhalla and found it in need of repairs.

South Carolina law code Sec. 4-1-90 provides for furnishing rooms for courts and public officers when the Courthouse is unusable.

Therefore, this is a demand that upon moving the court, the County Council cause a sign to be posted at the new Courthouse building entrance on Short Street and at 205 W Main Street indicating this is the temporary location of the Oconee County Courthouse and that this temporary status remain in place until such time that the legal number of qualified voters approve the move of our court to the Short Street location. The sign should be sufficient to notify persons approaching the building that this is a temporary location.

Until voters have legally approved the move of our court, this demand includes that all plaques, name plates, letterhead and other official designation referring to the address and location of the Short Street Courthouse building indicate that this building is a temporary location for the Oconee County Courthouse.
