ITEM TITLE OR DESCRIPTION:

Transfer of road paving funds from the operating budget of FY 2009-2010 to the capital projects fund.

BACKGROUND OR HISTORY:

The Road Department has approximately \$1.3 million of unexpended paving funds available in FY 2009-2010.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS OR CONCERNS:

At the Council meeting June 15, 2010, it was originally intended to add these funds to an existing purchase order to Venesky Asphalt for additional roads to be added to the 2009-2010 Road Paving Bid. Venesky would not agree to hold the unit prices for the bid, so the County Administrator recommended putting these additional roads out for a new bid. There was not enough time to advertise a bid and award it before June 30, 2010, when these funds needed to be encumbered. Therefore, if the funds are transferred to the capital projects fund, they will then be available in July 2010 when the new bid can be awarded. It is expected that the paving will be completed by November of 2010.
