[Mountain Springs Rezoning]

The proposed ordinance 2012-25 stems from a citizen-initiated small area rezoning request citizen-initiated rezoning request submitted by Mr. Jess Neville. The request consists of approximately 101 parcels, consisting of approximately 1348 acres in the vicinity of Mountain Springs Rd in Oconee County. The parcels are located in the rural suburban area on the Future Land Use Map. As submitted all parcels would be rezoned into Traditional Rural

District. Petitions containing the signatures at least 51% of the owners of the parcels in the request area were submitted in support of the proposal.

It is the staff's recommendation that Council approve Ordinance 2012-25 on first reading [in title only] and forward the ordinance to the Planning Commission for their required review/recommendation.

First Reading [in title only] of Ordinance 2012-27 'AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER AND CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN OCONEE COUNTY REAL PROPERTY IN THE OCONEE COUNTY COMMERNCE PARK; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO''

11. Discussion & Possible Action Items

RFP 11-21 / Strategic Plan / Economic Development Consultant Services / \$49,755.00

RFP 11-21 was issued on March 15, 2012, to seek qualified consultants to develop a strategic plan for the economic development of Oconee County. This plan should analyze past and present efforts for efficiency and pair those successes with a new strategic plan containing new and innovative measures. Ultimately this plan should help create jobs and foster a more sustainable and diversified economy. It should serve as a mechanism for coordinating the efforts of individuals, organizations, private industry, and local government concerned with Oconee County's economic development. The last Strategic Plan was completed in 2007.

Twenty-five firms were notified of this RFP and eleven proposals were received on April 19, 2012. An Evaluation Committee consisting of Jim Alexander, Economic Development Director, Richard Blackwell, Economic Development Executive Director, Glenn Breed, Assistant County Administrator, Hank Field, Economic Development Commission, and Russell Johnson, Project & Marketing Manager for Economic Development reviewed and scored the proposals and recommended three firms to continue on to the Interview Round. Interviews were held on May 31, 2012 and RKG Associates, Inc. of Alexandria, VA, was recommended for award. RKG Associates agreed to the County's contract terms and their not to exceed price was within the budgeted amount.

It is the staff's recommendation that Council approve the award of RFP 11-21 to RKG Associates, Inc., of Alexandria, VA, for the not to exceed amount of \$49,755.00.

ITB 11-25 / Road Paving 2011-2012 (2) / \$196,405.20

On May 22, 2012, formal sealed bids were opened for paving of approximately two (2) miles of County roads (see attached Tentative Road List). Twenty-seven companies were originally notified of this bid opportunity with two companies submitting bids. Hubbard Paving and Grading submitted the lowest bid in the amount of \$350,983.60. This bid allowed the County to adjust the Road List based on the availability of funds. We have deleted the following roads from the Tentative Road List County Acres / WA-219, Ashley Drive / WA-271, Pawnee Drive / WA -303 and Lake Pointe East / SE-306 which will make the Contract for ITB 11-25 \$176,764.68

It is the staff's recommendation that Council approve the Award of ITB 11-25, Road Paving 2011-2012 (2) to Hubbard Paving and Grading, Inc of Walhalla, SC in the amount of \$176,764.68 plus contingency in the amount of \$19,604.52 for a total award of \$196,405.20. Staff also recommends Council authorize the County Administrator to approve any change orders within the contingency amount.

Request for Approval for Issuance of General Obligation Bond [GO Bond]

This is a request for Council to approve the issuance of the GO Bond to support the construction of a new Anderson-Oconee Behavioral Health Services facility and to approve entering into a contractual relationship for the repayment of said GO Bond.
