Oconee County Council met at 6:00 PM in Council Chambers, 415 South Pine Street, Walhalla, SC with all Council Members, County Administrator Scott Moulder, Assistant Administrator Glenn Breed, County Attorney Thomas Martin and Clerk to Council Elizabeth G. Hulse present.

Mr. Thrift called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Mr. Thrift noted that this meeting will be short; dealing only with issues that are time sensitive due to the sudden death of Council District III Representative, Archie Barron, on Monday, January 20, 2014, at 4:30 p.m.

**Mr. Archie Barron**  
**1936 - 2014**

Mr. Thrift stated that this meeting was taking place with heavy heart having lost a very dear friend in Mr. Barron. Mr. Thrift noted that he had spoken with Mr. Barron several times in the last week and that his concern was not with his failing health but his desire to meet his commitment to serve the citizens of Oconee County. He stated that Mr. Barron was always prepared for meetings and studied the issues thoroughly before making a decision. Mr. Thrift reminisced about his years of friendship and his time working on Council together; noting, “*you could always disagree with Archie without him being disagreeable*”. Mr. Thrift asked all to keep the Barron family and his friends in their prayers in the coming weeks.

Mr. Corbeil reiterated many of the things said by Mr. Thrift. In addition he noted that Mr. Barron excelled at everything he did and that “*he made our lives richer*”.

Mr. Dexter said Mr. Barron would be sorely missed by those who knew him. He noted Mr. Barron’s extensive work in the community prior to joining Council and that he was an asset to the Council team.

Mr. Martin, County Attorney, stated that Mr. Barron was “*the consummate southern gentleman*”. In addition, he stated that it had been a pleasure to get to know Mr. Barron who was always professional when dealing with any issue.

## **Public Hearing for the Following Ordinances**

**ORDINANCE 2013-08** "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 26-11, ENTITLED *IDENTIFY ROADS IN THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM*, OF DIVISION 1, ENTITLED *UNIFIED ROAD STANDARDS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF OCONEE COUNTY*, OF CHAPTER 26, ENTITLED *ROADS AND BRIDGES*, OF THE OCONEE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; AMEND THE OFFICIAL OCONEE COUNTY ROAD MAP INCORPORATED THEREIN; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO"

**Resolution R2014-03** "A RESOLUTION MAKING APPLICATION TO THE STATE BUDGET AND CONTROL BOARD OF SOUTH CAROLINA FOR APPROVAL OF THE ISSUANCE BY OCONEE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, OF ITS NOT EXCEEDING \$3,100,000 SPECIAL SOURCE REFUNDING REVENUE BOND, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SOUTH CAROLINA CODE ANNOTATED, TITLE 4, CHAPTER 1 AND 29 (1976), AS AMENDED"
